

I smiled and asked the young lady behind the counter to give me two more breakfast meals on a separate tray. I then walked around the corner to the table that the men had chosen as a resting spot. I put the tray on the table and laid my hand on the blue-eyed gentleman's cold hand. He looked up at me with tears in his eyes, and said, 'Thank you'.



#### Vanuatu

From the 2nd until the 13th of May, Brothers Johnny Dimov, Paul Moffitt, Adrian Gray and Justin Lane went to Vanuatu to continue the missionary work that has been in a progressive state since our introduction to the country in 2005. Bro' Paul, Bro' Johnny and Bro' Justin went to Malakula Island and Pentecost Island while I (Bro' Adrian) went to Ambrym and Ambae Islands. The time, money and spiritual input into this country is bearing fruits that have given the native people there access to the message where they can see the fulfillment of the Word unfolding in their own personal lives.

Over the past year I have written a number of articles on Vanuatu and the work that has been done there to the glory of God. But without the prayers and help of the Saints throughout New Zealand and Bro' Johnny's fellowship in Caboolture in Queensland, and from Phoenix in the USA, things would be vastly different

It is encouraging to stand in these pulpits that the Saints have made available to us and watch as the "lights go on in their hearts" and changes start taking place - some faster than others - but changes nevertheless.

Bro' Justin Lane came with us to do the electrical work in setting up the solar panels. These were such a problem for us getting them into the country with all the red-tape coming from the airlines. I wish to thank him for the sacrifice he has made in building these systems that can be used for MP3 players, lighting and laptops. The generators that have been donated to these churches are in fine condition and used for the brethren's purposes only. They have all been serviced and were used by the three brothers as well as myself on this visit.

I was asked a question as to how long the electrical equipment would last under normal use. My reply was that the machinery will survive until the body change and after that the gear can fall to bits, rust and rot as we won't be here to concern ourselves with the inventions of man. But until then we'll be good stewards of what we have.

Next month Bro' Renato and Bro' Nahum go to Ambrym Island for 10 days to do building work on one of the houses there which will be of benefit to ministers passing through and also for storage of the church's tapes and books. Please pray that they will achieve their goal. Thank you to Bro' Paul and Bro' Johnny for the teamwork that made the visit to Vanuatu a collective success.

### Middle East: "A New Reality"?

Greetings once again in Jesus name, from the Middle East. We have just returned from another profitable outreach into Syria our 5th. It was very remarkable indeed. The Word went forth with power, touching hearts that had not yet heard the restored, end time truths. Your prayers and support are greatly appreciated as the same Gospel Paul preached is being re-established in Damascus and other parts of Syria. This has also led to further opportunities to share the Word in other nations.

While we were in Syria we had the most unique and unusual experience of attending the debut release of the docu-drama on the life of the Apostle Paul. What is so outstanding about this film, is that not only is it sanctioned, but it is being promoted by the Syrian Government - which is Muslim. Leading Muslim Clerics were on hand for this event, along side Catholic Bishops, Orthodox Patriarchs and Evangelical Pastors. It was publically stated during the ceremonies that through this film and related events, the Government of Syria intends to show the world that Christians and Muslims can peacefully cohabitate together. Even more outstanding was the fact that every actor in this dramatic film - was Muslim!

Living here also provides us with a unique "pulse" on events. As much as I want to share some wonderful testimonies, I feel impressed to highlight some very important things currently taking place, which are lining up with great potential for the fulfillment of long awaited prophecies.

U.S. Senator John Kerry, the Chairman of the Senate Foreign Relations Committee, was quoted as saying in the article written by Meredith Buel in Washington on May 7th; "There is a new reality - moderate Arab countries and Israel alike are actually more worried together about Iran than they are about each other. As a result, they are now cooperating in ways that were unimaginable just a couple of years ago."

The Pope is mid way through his excur-

sion to Jordan and Israel. He is pictured here

largest Mosque in Jordan where he spoke and prayed. We know that the



last great bastion or "hold-out" from the Pope's leadership - has been Islam. This is changing as the King of Jordan called on the Pope to help bring peace between these two great religions and stressed the "importance of co-existence and harmony between Muslim and Christian".

In fulfilling a campaign promise, President Obama just announced that he will be in Egypt on June 4th for his greatly anticipated speech of reconciliation with Muslims. The tide of tolerance among Arab/Muslim too is turning against zealots and fanatics like the Taliban and Hezbollah.This is evidenced by the Pakistani Government's new, "all out offensive"against the Taliban. Egypt too sent a strong message against extremist forces by recently arresting Hezbollah operatives that have been there for years.

In Iran too we see "reformists" gaining the upper hand in their upcoming elections. The campaigning in Lebanon for the June 7th election is also very revealing. Muslim's here are joining up with "Christian" parties to form a coalition. Whoever would have ever imagined it possible to see a billboard featuring a Mosque and a Church side by side captioned with; "Time for Change"?

As I sit here and write, I ponder the possibility that the stage is being set for "Peace, Peace" [1Thess 5:3] - right here in Lebanon, whose population is split almost equally between Muslim and Christian. The Pope's influence in Lebanon both politically and militarily - is unparalleled in the entire Middle East. If a peaceful coalition is attained here, the effects will be dramatic. The Pope will certainly be in a position - unlike anytime in history - to affect changes in Israel. How the world will marvel at the wonder of his reconciling all three major faiths of the world and then positioning himself in the one location where these three great religions converge -Jerusalem. How close are we? Please keep us in your prayers as these events continue to unfold and as we boldly declare His Word.

### Middle East: Peace, Peace, Peace?

How exciting it is to be living in these days as we continue to see events in the



world correlate with those in Scripture. Pope In Al Asga.

Any time a Pope visits the Middle East and especially Jerusalem, it is certainly noteworthy. Pope Benedict, the second Pope in history to visit Jerusalem, amazed the world last week as the first Pope to set foot on the Temple Mount, as seen here entering Islam's third holiest shrine. Is it any wonder that the objective of his visit to the Middle East was summarized by just three words: "Peace, Peace, Peace" ?!

Other incredible things are taking place that were 'unthinkable' just a short while ago. Israeli Prime Minister Netanyahu (an ardent opponent to granting the Palestinian territories separate State status) now appears prepared to reverse his stand as evidenced by this statement which Israeli Defence Minister Ehud Barak told Channel 2TV on Saturday, "I think and believe that Netanyahu will tell Obama this government is prepared to go for Continued on Page 8

a political process that will result in two nations living side by side in peace and mutual



respect.

This change is no doubt facilitated by the fact that a recent Israeli poll found 58% of the population supports such a venture for peace.

Shimon Peres summarized his recent meetings with King Abjullah of Jordan by saying "our talks were very constructive, friendly and warm" and that he "sees eye-to-eye" with the king, especially on his call for a swift settlement to the lingering Arab-Israeli conflict. "We want peace. We don't consider the Palestinians as our enemy, but our friends and neighbours." Peres went on to say, "We don't consider Islam our enemy."

Another fact that confirms the momentum building for prospects of peace in the Middle East is that an alliance exists "of 57 Arab and Muslim states that are willing to bury the hatchet and forget the past for the sake of future generations. The peoples of these nations are looking to Obama to deliver on their hopes for prosperity and peace. The only question is whether Obama can meet the challenge." The terrorist party, Hamas, has been stressing the point lately that they have nothing in common with the virulently anti-western al Qaida, as they endeavour to reach out to the West and Israel.

While the terrors and crimes of Islamic radicals cannot be marginalized, we must not lose sight of our focus in The Word concerning endtime events. If Islam or some Sheik truly were the embodiment of the antichrist, would not The Holy Spirit have directed His Prophet to identify such a threat? The Message is strangely silent on this point – with-

out even a hint of reference. As murderous as Stalin and the Communist regime was in the time of God's Prophet, The Word of The Lord to the elect then was ".Do not fear communism." Are we any less discerning to demonize the wrong target today as was done back then? Without a scriptural identification, Islam is merely a "tool" in the hand of God to bring about the events that serve to facilitate the true terror – the beast behind the 'purple curtain'.

We experienced this firsthand in our detention last year with Hizbollah, who were more polite than the Chinese police and released us without harm. Recently the Bishop in charge of the exclusive Catholic TV station, Tele Lumiere, said on his weekly program in obvious reference to our work, "beware the dangers of the false prophet, William Branham's teachings.." Our experience here is that Muslims are less antagonistic and more polite to hear the truth – than those of Catholic or Evangelical backgrounds!

Given these events and the fact that there are no established Message works among Nationals in the Middle East [except in one country - Iran], you can appreciate the immense challenge we face in preaching and spreading the Truth. As great as the challenge is, we endure and press on. The two messages "Life Story" and "How The Angel Came to Me" have just been translated into Arabic. We covet your prayers and support and invite you to share in our anticipation of what the future of this fledgling work may grow into. You can view a short video clip [on the following web site] of Arabic worship in the apartment converted into a place of worship where we hold regular services to strengthen and encourage the new believers.

#### TESTIMONIES OF PERSONAL BIRTH PAINS



### Israeli Innovation: Watering Fields With Dew

(IsraelNN.com) A new method for irrigating fields has been developed in Israel and will be presented at the upcoming International Agritech Exhibition 2009 in Tel Aviv.

The water crisis in Israel and throughout the world is expediting the development of technological solutions for reducing the amount of water used in agriculture. In the new method, dew that falls during the night is channeled and used to irrigate produce.

Normally, drops of dew that fall on a field would not reach a plant's roots since the small amount of water doesn't penetrate deep into the soil. But with the new technology, the drops of dew that fall all around the plant are directed to the few inches surrounding the center of the



plant so that the roots get nourishment.

The product was developed by Tal Ya [lit.

Dew of G-d], an agricultural start-up company located near Netanya in Moshav Gan Yoshiya.

In a series of tests conducted by the Ministry of Agriculture and the <u>Agricultural</u> <u>Research Organization</u>, integration of the new watering method saved at least 50% of water and fertilizer usage.

"Most watering systems spread the water all around the field such that much of the water seeps into the ground away from the plants' roots and much of the water evaporates," explains Avi Tamir, the founder of Tal Ya. "Our product both delivers the water right to the roots, and traps the evaporated water and recycles it back into the plant."

Since fertilizer is commonly mixed into the watering systems, reduction in water amounts is accompanied by an equal reduc-


tion in fertilizer. This fact represents significant savings for farmers in light of the sharp rise in fertilizer prices. It also reduces the pollution of ground water caused by excess fertilizer.


According to the developers, the financial outlay in purchasing the product is earned back in one season of produce.

The Tal Ya company will present its product at the upcoming Agritech 2009 Exhibition and intends to find a partner to market the product in the Israeli and world markets.

The 17th International Agricultural Exhibition will be held on May 5-7, 2009 at the Tel Aviv Exhibition Grounds. Two hundred and fifty companies will present innovations in agriculture and irrigation, developed both in Israel and abroad. Some 25 ministers and deputy ministers of agriculture from around the world will attend along with delegations from dozens of countries.
