Pangasinan is a region in the northern Philippines which has a regional capital called Lingayan. In this town is a small message church called "Rainbow Trout Tabernacle" that my wife and I visited between the 1st to the 8st of October. The pastor of this church is Bro Bonie Tamayo. What is unique about this church is that it has kept itself separated from the fanaticism that has flooded the message ranks in this nation. They have separated themselves from false doctrine, politics, false prophets and hero ministries that have cankered many message groups.

This was the 3rd time I had been invited to take meetings here and the purpose this time was to dedicate the church after many years of them living under the threat of eviction off the lot their church was built on. Their church was built on land that was owned by a man who was demanding them to either buy it or they had to dismantle and leave.

Earlier this year they had one month left before eviction to pay for the land which was valued at 2.5 million Pesos or \$NZ 90,000. The average income is \$NZ120 per month. Humanly speaking their days were doomed, but not to the Lord. After much prayer and believing the Lord a sister in the church received an inheritance from her past Jewish employer which not only was enough to pay the price of the land, but was enough to finish the church building and its furniture as well as build apartments for visiting ministers.

On Sunday the 4th of October we had a thanksgiving and ribbon cutting ceremony in which the newly renovated church and apartments were officially opened.

However while the blessings were falling here, the typhoons were bringing calamity to much of the nation. Manila had been struck by "Typhoon Ondoy" the previous week and 350 people had lost their lives and a million made homeless. Off the coast during our meetings was what the experts called a "super typhoon" called Typhoon Palma. It was lingering there and just bringing intermittent rain. Our Sunday opening and thanksgiving feast went well under a marquee tent. But in the mountains nearby the rain was filling the dam, which had to eventually have its floodgates opened. As the day of our leaving arrived on the 8th, the typhoon intensified in the mountains and wiped out villages, families and farm land in their rice harvest time. The streets of Dagupan where we walked the


previous day were under water. That night as we flew to Singapore another 350 were to lose their lives.

But The Lord protected us and that little church that had separated itself unto Him. The third pull message of the revealed Word, caught this portion of Rainbow Trout Bride in Lingayan many years ago, and the rainbow trout has responded back with thanksgiving for the great things God has done in their lives.

My thanks go out to the Saints who through much prayer made a way for the blessings to fall in the midst of judgments on the earth.

Re: Mission Work

I hope what I have to say will be of some use.

Mission work is a vital part of any church's life or any believer's life. We are told in Mk 16:15 And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. Mt 28:19 Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost 20. Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you alway, even unto the end of the world. Amen.

Although we as a church have always tried to do this over the 26 years that we have been going, the recent treacherous earthquakes and tsunamis around the Pacific area, make us all realise that we live in perilous times and it has caused us to once again take up our positions as The Lord has told us to in His Word.

We made enquiries to see if we could help in Samoa and the Philippines, and learnt that Samoan believers were on the northern side of the island and the storm didn't affect them so much as those on the south side. However, the Philippines was a different story as some of the believers there suffered great losses of their possessions in the massive flooding.

Being we all cannot go into the mission field, we have tried to find faithful men around the world who are good stewards of any resources we could provide. Despite a few initial errors, our Lord has graciously given us some brothers who we have confidence in. We often hear from these brothers who we send an offering to each month. This helps us, as a church, in three ways:

- We feel a part of their ministry and we become identified with them in their work for the Lord.
- We can now pray more effectively for their ministry as they let us know their needs.
- We also can rejoice in their victories as they share them with us.

Because we are now living in perilous times we not only want to help in translation work but also to meet some of the believers' basic needs.

The government, through the Charities Commission, has changed the ruling on how much money we can send overseas.

We are looking to help those believers in the Philippines by giving to a brother who will be responsible for distribution of our funds sent. If you or your church would like to participate in this relief effort, I am happy to send you the brother's name and bank details or you can join with us.

Paul speaks of this sort of thing in Romans 15:25-27 But now I go unto Jerusalem to minister unto the saints. 26. For it hath pleased them of Macedonia and Achaia to make a certain contribution for the poor saints which are at Jerusalem. 27. It hath pleased them verily; and their debtors they are. For if the Gentiles have been made partakers of their spiritual things, their duty is also to minister unto them in carnal things.

Brother Jeff Jenkins discusses Bro T new missionary outreach in the Middle East.

What we are about to see thrilled me because of the Biblical implications. We are now establishing a beach head, a work of God, right next to Israel – Jerusalem - where it all started. And in the nation of Lebanon, in the little city of Antilius.

Brother Tony and his precious wife, Rebecca, as you know, have been working with Brother Byskal for years. He has been behind the scenes, doing a lot of the missionary work in China and in India and in various places around the world.

But now, Brother T feels led to settle in Lebanon. And God is already using him, as you are going to see on this DVD. (Available from Nelson Bible Believers) I know it's going to be a tremendous blessing to you and we are going to do our best to support Bro. T And I am just soliciting your help - as well your prayers and your finances.

Our brother is doing this by himself, without a lot of support from other places. It's a virgin work. Basically, what I am really saying is that Israel was the first frontier by which and through which the Gospel went out. Now, we are back; we have made the circle and this is now the last frontier. So these are exciting times and as you can see on this DVD and I know it will be a blessing to you.

in one hour and forty minutes Bro.T is going to go through 180 slides to convey to you what God has already done in a short time. That short time so encouraged Bro. T Rebecca that they have decided to live in Lebanon and devote their time and energies, full time to that area. One of the many supernatural things have already taken place. There's a book out about visions and dreams of what the Muslim people are receiving, of actual visions and dreams about Jesus Christ - Him being the Saviour - and they're literally coming to Christ by the hundreds and the thousands, right now. It's very supernatural, what God is doing for these people who are divided. There have been many factions and fractures within their faith. There

are a lot of them that are having a conflict of their faith right now.

They're looking and they're searching and they're finding that one common denominator is the love of the believer - the Christian. When a Christian testifies to a Muslim and they open the Bible to the N.T. where Jesus is saying, 'Love your enemies', this is so profound and it is speaking to them and then their neighbours are being touched. The Christians are touching the Muslim neighbours. So right now, what is happening is supernatural. Like I said, both visions and dreams, as well as the missionary and the individual Christian spreading the Gospel. We will make this book available to you so that you can get this book telling about the supernatural visions and dreams that people are having.

On top of that, God has now put it on T and Rebecca's hearts to go there full time. And while Tony was there, he went to a church just to spread the gospel and after the service, a man came up and asked him if he would like to go for lunch. So T and Rebecca went with him and his wife to their home for lunch, as God would have it. The providence of God! T found himself sipping tea with the vice-president of Spirit Television, there in Lebanon. The one person who could put us here in Limo, Ohio, on the air in Lebanon, with Global Answers. So we found that incredibly compelling.

We know it was the hand of God, and so, right now, we are making a series of videos in 8mins segments, completely orchestrated for the Muslim people, to reach them, as well as for the Christian Orthodox and Catholic people that are also in the vicinity. There's a lot of outreach to be done there. Again, what is exciting is that the first frontier is now the last frontier. And I want to read you a Scripture, just to remind you: Matt 24:27 For as the lightning [or the sun] cometh out of the east [the gospel started in the east] and shineth even to the west so shall also the coming of the Son of Man be.

So, as we know it, the Gospel went out of Jerusalem in the Middle East and is gone across the channel to Europe, and now, across the ocean to America [Assuzu St; the opening of the Seven Seals; God sending a mighty Prophet. All in the West. And now, the Gospel has gradually gone back to the East again and we are literally on the doorstep of Jerusalem itself – the East again. We have made the complete circle!

This is an exciting time. This woman who is the vice-president of Spirit Television, has already told us that we can go on air there. It will be \$500 per half hour, as they'll put it into Arabic for us, and that means that they are going to take it from English into the Arabic script and then they'll put a voice over it in some form in which the people will be able to hear it in their own tongue. – So, we're very close to when the Jews will find out that Jesus Christ who they crucified, IS THEIR MESSIAH.

A QUESTIONARE FOR BRO MATTHAN

Here we are, bro Matthan! - with a few 'Q'uestions we just thought to ask you! Bro Charles...

Q. When do you remember first hearing the Message that meant something to you'?

A. The Word has fascinated me from my very first memories; all I have ever loved to do is place the scriptures and the message for this day.

O. What did that do in your heart?

A. I purposed to learn the Word and the art of wielding it; I spend hours each day studying and contemplating upon it. I have seen many people beat about the bush, waffle, and guess when they speak of the Word and that made me vow to never mince my words or my actions.

Q. Did The Lord give you any specific Word for yourself that you will never forget?

A. Revelation 10 states that the Bible is an open book to the Bride. Fuelled by this knowledge I began to query why people did not explore the intricacies of The Word: the genealogies, the laws, the mathematics, the mysteries, the parallels, and the prophecies. Thus I purposed to explore the great depths of The Word and minister something fresh (and beneficial) to the people for them to see that people's self-imagined "cuddly Jesus" is in reality the supreme Judge with a vision that the Bride must and "will" fulfill because She has His vision.

Q. Did anyone else give you encouragement, such as Dad and Mum?

A. Dad and Mum have supported me wholeheartedly from the beginning. They have offered tips as to how I could improve my presentation, advised me as to how I could make my sermons more easily understood, corrected me when I have made terrible blunders whilst preaching, and given me a free night off from washing the dishes if a sermon was exceptional. Much of Dad's imparted knowledge concerning the Word has kept me from venturing into areas where I was not accurate.

Q. What age were you when you felt a calling to minister?

A. When I was eight years old I would go up the farm and preach, pretending that each blade of grass was a member of the congregation. (I always had a large congregation except in a drought). When I was 13 years old I asked Dad to ask bro Paul Moffitt if I could take a service. The result was my ministering on a Wednesday night with shaking knees and a dry throat, but it was a good meeting. I have ministered intermittently ever since and thoroughly enjoy it. And I am pacing myself nowadays and the congregation are thus able to read the opening scriptures with me and enjoy the comfort of their seats for some minutes before they are dismissed.

Q. What were the circumstances?

A. I felt the urge to minister because I wanted to express what the LORD was showing me in The Word. I refused and refuse the attempts of self-styled "top brass" message people to hold me back. For God to use a person, that person must be willing to rise from rest to do war. I will break the chains, smash down the walls, and burn the forts of any spirit that tries to withstand the gift God has placed in my life. The Word is a sword, an instrument of battle, and I will use it because I know how to use it.

Q. Have you had an experience in The Lord that you would like to share with us?



A. In my 21 years of living I have finally realised this principle, "Speak the Word, then go and possess that which you have spoken". I was always a shy person and afraid to speak up for that which is truth. My utter frustration with my own weaknesses drove me to take God seriously and now all of Hell takes me seriously. I want to be an example before all the young people upon the earth that it is possible to remain clean and sane whilst mankind drifts into insanity.

Psalm 30:1-5. I will extol thee, O Lord; for thou hast lifted me up, and hast not made my foes to rejoice over me. O Lord my God, I cried unto thee, and thou hast healed me. O Lord, thou hast brought up my soul from the grave: thou hast kept me alive, that I should not go down to the pit. Sing unto the Lord, O ye saints of his, and give thanks at the remembrance of his holiness. For His anger endureth but a moment; in his favour is life: weeping may endure for a night, but joy cometh in the morning.

May God bless the reading of His Word. You may be seated for a while in His Presence. We're so glad this morning in that 'the joy of The Lord is the strength of His people.' Amen. So, JOY, you know, maybe we can't explain it, but we like to express it. But we can express joy and joy is expressed in many ways. Amen. So this morning we realise joy. I'm just looking at the day this morning and unless we have experienced the wet season and the gloom and the want of cast and the cold, we cannot enjoy and appreciate a day like this. Amen? And you cannot appreciate day unless you've had night, so neither can you appreciate joy unless you have had sorrow. Many of us this morning, we get sick and many of us have experiences in our lives.

And I think of what David said in Psalms about being in the night season. He said that in the night season, many times we like to rehearse the bad things that happen in our life. We like to speak about the bad things and David speaks about 'my bones have been broken' and about pain and in that situation, he said, 'I cried unto God but He didn't answer.' But then the Bible goes on, and David says, 'But God inhabits the praises of His people.' So, unless we learn to praise Him, we like to rehearse the bad things that happen. We like to rehearse about 'how I lost my job and I can't pay my mortgage, and my car's repossessed — my home is repossessed and my kids are sick and my wife — this and that.

Now, God knows those things in your life because The Bible says, before The Word is formed on my tongue, he says, God knows it. So He knows our situations. He knows these things, so for me to come before His presence, Brothers, you too rehearse those things...God don't need it. But in The Bible, David says, 'He inhabits our praises'. So, in your time of trouble, you know it isn't easy to praise God, when everything is going wrong. It's not easy to praise God, Brothers, when you've lost your job and you've worked all your life to build up something for your family, for your future and all of a sudden, things happen when you lose your job and you can't manage your commitments and, Brother, if you can't manage your commitments, then the Bank will close and it is not easy to worship Him in that time.

But I want to tell you that the secret is that when you do worship Him, when you do praise Him, then God adds Himself to you, because the Bible says, 'God inhabits the praises of His people'. So, He comes and He keeps close by you in your situation. I've always thought, you know, how The Bible speaks about Paul and Silas in prison at night after a hard day – they're bloody, maybe jaw broken, backs lacerated because they have been persecuted for preaching the Gospel and they find themselves in prison, in the stocks, standing in pools of blood and they must have thought to themselves at midnight, 'We might as well have church'.

And The Bible said, 'At midnight they started worshipping Him. They started praising Him. At midnight they started lifting up their hands. Maybe they stamped their feet. And you know what happened, Brothers? The Bible says that the prison was shaken. There was an earthquake that struck the prison. It was not God trying to get them out, but God trying to get in, because The Bible says, 'God inhabits the praises of His people'. You start worshipping God when you're in trouble. You try it! [Bro. We thank God for your prayers, for our Lord's protection and His strength in these treacherous days. Here on the mission field we find ourselves not only in the "hunt" for the elected Seed of God, but also being the "hunted". This past week again, Brother

was summoned by the priests and sternly forbidden to have any religious meetings or even gatherings – or there would be consequences.

Consequently, our meetings are taking on the nature of spiritual "guerrilla warfare". Retreat to obscurity, stealthily advance
and strike with the Word, retreat and strike
again in a different location. So our meetings
are moved from house to house. This has become a necessity in order to keep those who
are watching - "guessing" about our movements. In so doing we are ensuring the fledgling group of the elect are not stymied or hindered in receiving their spiritual food.

So what does lay ahead for the Bride? Isn't this our destiny in the last days according to the Prophet? The dates are as follows; Oct 17 & 18 in Lebanon and Oct 22-25 in Egypt.

We confidently trust the Lord to not only bless these meetings with His supernatural presence, but also to open eyes and ears to the present day Truth. Your prayers for the success of these meetings are certainly coveted. You will recall from the last Egypt report that some were also considering true water baptism. May the Lord bless these souls with spiritual revelation to take this step of faith. We are looking to the Lord for Him to move in a special way and also for His provisions as we host these meetings.

On behalf of the Elect Bride in the Middle East, thank you for your prayers and support, may the Lord richly bless you.

Middle East: Along The Banks Of The Nile...

Sunset: If you've been following recent



events with us here in the Middle East, you're aware of the pressure mounting against us and the ministry of the Truth. As we sought the Lord in prayer for wisdom and direction, it seemed good to us by the Holy Spirit to move onto other "things" for a season.

And thus a spiritual mission into Egypt was born.

We had contacts there from our earlier visit last year, and also by references from those met in Saudi Arabia. Though contact with them was made, the door the Lord opened in a very effectual way was through an Egyptian minister we had been sharing the Message with in Syria.

Through Brother we were introduced to his good friend and co-minister; Brother Together they had been very instrumental in planting about 15 underground "home churches". With Brother return home to Egypt from Syria- the Lord confirmed that the time was right to visit them.

IMG_4192When attending underground home churches, great care is taken for both our own protection and those that gather. The practise being that people come in small groups of 2-3 at a time with arrivals spaced out over 20-30 minutes so as not to attract attention. It's an eerie feeling walking in silence through darkened alleys and up dimly lit stairways – but an important precaution as speaking English would certainly jeopardize the gathering and our safety.

The Lord blessed us in a great way in our first meeting. Hearts were touched by The Word which so greatly impressed those who heard. The positive report spread like fire. This of course resulted in many more opportunities for the ministry. Thus began our week long campaign going from "house to house".

No experience I know, compares with preaching the revelation of The Word to those who have never heard – and are so hungry for truth. Of course to follow Christ in these staunch Muslim nations requires a deep desperation and determination. It was a great exhilaration to preach the Message to these sincere and desperate souls eager for a deeper spiritual experience. It was like watching a dry wizened plant unfold with vitality as it received life-giving water.

Baptism: As in Lebanon, being baptized in Egypt is an "offense". For this reason, those in Egypt who want to follow The Word have to endure great personal risk. In spite of the risks - we found a quiet eddy along the banks of the Nile River in which to fulfill the Word of God. There we baptized Brother — and his wife. Our boldness to act upon the Word along with the revelation that was quickened by the Spirit to the hearts of others that heard, caused many others to express their desire to be baptized.

This included many of the house church leaders that I spoke with on Thursday night – which makes our return trip that much more eminent.



As we fin-

ished one night of ministry, the owner of the home led us in prayer, thanking God for the ministry of The Word and said; "...oh God, how jealous I am of Brother T and Brother jealous of their revelation and understanding of the scriptures! I thank you for sending them here to us tonight and I pray a blessing upon them and all those who are supporting them in sending them to us here in Egypt!"

IMG 4238 Yes, in helping support us with your prayers and love, you too are reaping the reward of seeing these souls come to Christ and maturity in His Word. As you remember us in

your prayers I'd also ask that you please add Brother one of the house church leaders you see here. A lovely and sincere brother who has embraced the truth, and he is sadly



afflicted with Parkinson's disease. We had prayer together and are believing that the Lord will honour the prayer of faith and also confirm His Word to those who have been eager to receive.



Uganda

Background

Uganda is a land locked country of some 30 million people in East Africa. Its neighbours are Sudan, Kenya, Tanzania, Rwanda and the Congo. Sitting on the equator at an altitude of about 4,000 feet, Uganda covers 236,580 square kilometres of which some 25% is lakes and rivers. It lies on the western and northern coast



of Lake Victoria, the second largest fresh water lake in the world and source of the Nile. Although its official languages are English and Swahili, Luganda is probably the most widely spoken. The Eltham Message Church is working with a group of six Ugandan ministers to translate and print Brother Branham's Messages in the Luganda language.

Update

Eight new translations have just been added to the 10 messages already translated. The new messages are: Leadership, By Faith Moses, Patriarch Abraham, Going Beyond The Camp, Restoration Of The Bride Tree, Anointed Ones At The End Time, Paul A Prisoner Of Jesus Christ and What Shall I Do With Jesus Called Christ. Currently being translated is Birth Pains. Balita Hannington, our project leader, added in his email report, "For It's The Rising Of The Sun' - the translator didn't get the very thought of the prophet and we put it on hold." It is great

New Print Station

Brother Hannington has spent some time in Kampala, the capital of Uganda, helping set up a new print station. Pastor Robert Kabasi runs a church of some 30 believers in Kampala. There are quite a few Message Churches in Kampala but few, if any, Message Books. We have been able to fund a new computer and duplex printer at Brother Robert's home to make both English and Lugandan messages more readily available in the capital. Brother Robert has been a long time friend and he is looking foward to having his church help supply the Bride's needs in Kampala.

Outreach

Just finishing now is a special print run of some 4,000 booklets of the first ten messages translated. These are for new message churches in and around Kiboga, about 5 Hours drive west of our main printing base in Kamuli. Several of our translators have been involved in bringing the message to this area and they felt the need for message books to help strengthen the new assemblies.

Brother Hannington along with Brother Paul Musulube (our proof reader and grammerian) have been on a missions trip and report, "Am happy in the Lord, for He gave us a safe journey to and fro in our mission to Kenya and Tanzania.. We had a tremendous time of fellowship around God's Word in both countries. God confirmed it with signs and wonders and people believing this Truth for our day."

Brother Paul added, "Thanks for your prayers for we had nice time of fellowship with brother Hannington Baliita while in Mwanza, Tanzania where we went for a missionary trip. The people love the message and many will be baptised by the pastor in Jesus Holy name. Continue praying for us."

Psalm 100. Those words of love were sent
to me in a card from a Seventh Day Adventist.
They spoke to my heart in such a way that I
would read them again and again. I wanted
more...

Our children had left the family home and my husband was building us a new one in the country, when disaster struck. We both got sick and needed operations. We sold our lovely new home and moved back to live in the city. My husband never really recovered, also my health had begun to deteriorate rapidly having been diagnosed with Rheumatoid Arthritis and Micro Vascular Angina after a tumour was removed from my ear, and the untimely death of my husband had filled me with unbearable grief. Life to me had become meaningless (even though I had children & grandchildren).

Shortly after his death when returning home from work feeling that I couldn't take one day more, putting the car away in the garage I decided to take my life. As the exhaust fumes began to take control, being desperate, I cried, "If you are the God they say you are, forgive me". Almost immediately the phone in the house began to ring. I reached for the ignition key and turned OFF the engine.

Already taking a large amount of medication, anti depressants were now prescribed. Going for short walks would bring on an angina attack so for any kind of outing a wheelchair had to be supplied.

The decision was made that I should take early retirement from my government job. There seemed to be no end to this heartache. I was losing everything.

Brought up a Roman Catholic, I knew nothing else and wasn't looking for change in that area of my life. With all my health problems though, I had managed to obtain a parttime position working for the Catholic Bishop of Christchurch at the Cathedral of the Blessed Sacrament. I loved the job and seemed to be regaining my strength, but I was still unhappy. With this new found strength I took on more voluntary work and it was there that I met a Christian sister who introduced me to the Bible and its message.

Again I was hearing those wonderful words of truth that was sent to me several months ago. This time I was determined to believe and trust. I accepted her invitation to a church meeting to hear a visiting preacher. "But it's a protestant church service", I thought, but I wanted so much to hear what he had to say. He was speaking of his wife, the way she was dressed and her long hair. What he said made me look at the women in the congregation. Conviction took a hold of me and made me feel naked; I tried to cover that nakedness with the collar on my coat... I new then that I wasn't right with God!

Soon after that meeting I was given a vision of the waters of life and the feet of Christ walking Calvary's road. Each step that was taken was agony to me. I fell to my knees and surrendered my heart to Him... Changes in me were happening so quickly. I knew I would never be the same again.

I was attending the church fellowship on a regular basis and loving every word that was being preached. I had heard His voice: there was no going back to Catholicism.

Six weeks had passed since I had surrendered my heart and the Lord set the date for my baptism. I told my family and friends and invited them to come. My son was especially concerned though, that his 54 year old sick mother would be going in the freezing waters of the Ashley River in the depths of winter, and he tried hard to persuade me to wear his wet suit.

Glory filled my soul that day. I was blissfully happy, in love and wonderfully set free. Not realizing it at the time, but it was the very same day I had married my husband thirty years before. Praise God! It's all the Lords doing, and marvelous in my eyes.

He was providing everything I need-

ed for my Christian walk, even a new wardrobe. A friend came over to visit bringing
with her this huge suitcase. "Just for you" she
said. Its contents just amazed me. There were
eleven skirts, five blouses, two suits, three
cardigans, two dresses and one jacket. A pair
of black shoes was what I needed to make
everything complete. Dare I ask Him, after he
had provided so much? So I asked, and told
Him my shoe size. The very next morning
another friend brought over these beautiful black shoes she had bought on a visit to
the UK, but she could never wear them. They
were a perfect fit for me. It seemed I just had
to ask, and He supplied it!

As my joy in the Lord increased so did my health. I found I no longer needed the medication I was taking or the wheelchairs - I was walking freely.

The Bishop and my Parish priest were shocked at my decision to leave, and tried to convince me that their way was the truth. But the Lord had now shut tight those doors, and opened others - helping people at the Hospice who are terminally ill, and in bereavement counseling.

The Lord has been faithful to me just as he promised He would, with many miracles in my life.
