God's Messenger called home from Sodom

Evangelist Oral Roberts. ministered in New Zealand in 1965, rose from tent revivals to found a multimillion-dollar organisation - the Oral Roberts University. chartered in 1963, which became a Tulsa landmark. His spokesman A. Larry Ross said that the Reverend Oral Roberts, aged 91, died Tuesday the 15th of December 2009 of complications from pneumonia in Newport Beach, California. The evangelist was hospitalised after a fall on the Saturday. He had survived two heart attacks in the 1990s and a broken hip in 2006. God healed Oral Roberts of tuberculosis and a stuttering tongue at the age of 17, and he attributed that miracle as being the pivotal point that led him into his healing ministry. Today he holds a place amongst the country's most famous ministers. By the 1960s and '70s, the Oklahomaborn Oral Roberts was reaching millions around the world through broadcasting, publications and personal appearances.

A God's eye view of his underestimated importance to the world can be seen from reading nearly 400 recorded mentions by God's prophet William Branham, a selection of which are tabulated below.

Oral Roberts is a real good brother. He's a fine man. I remember Oral when we first met. He had a little ragged tent setting over in—in Kansas City, Missouri. I had a big auditorium over on the other side. Oral come set on the sideline that night, just a boy preacher and we got our pictures together out in the yard. He said, "Do you think God would hear my prayer for the sick, Brother Branham?" [cont'd over

I said, "He will hear anybody's prayer. He said, "Here I go." Now, I set on his sideline. 1

Oral Robert's role

I can't take Oral Roberts' ministry. And neither can Oral Roberts take mine. The Lord has given us both something to do ⁴.... We're two servants of Christ with two different ministries.⁵

The three stages of Israel's journey, the three messengers to Sodom, all these different things it would symbolize. It would symbolize the ministry of today. It would symbolize the message of Billy Graham of grace to the world; of Oral Roberts as power to the world; and of the Presence of Jesus Christ, as the last sign to the world.⁶

The fruit of the ministry

Now, what the Americans respond best to of the healing services, in my opinion is, well, of Brother Oral Roberts. Now, Brother Oral Roberts is a forceful speaker, a real preacher, and a good God-fearing brother - Brother Oral Roberts - and a bosom friend of mine, a lovely brother. And I have a great deep respect for Brother Roberts. And the Lord is with him and blessing him tremendously.

I've never seen anything like that building in Tulsa, of Brother Roberts, and I...be sure to see the mirror. When I went out to see that, those hands reaching for the cup of blessings, and I was just weeping for joy to know that even the ceiling, made out of little aluminium wires wove together...(I never see anything like it in my life.) And to think that one little boy, born in a dugout in Oklahoma, accomplished that, by faith. 11

We pray for Brother Oral Roberts, Your noble servant. And as we walk into this building tonight (in Tulsa), and see what the faith of one man can do, we thank Thee for him, Father. And we pray that You'll bless his ministry. Wherever he goes and what he does, may it prosper in Your hands. 12

I don't mean to condemn all television programs, nor all radio programs. If you want to look at television, watch Oral Roberts. He's got a good program. Watch that. If you want... That's okay. I'll endorse that a hundred percent. 15

The relationship with God's prophet

Then I went down to Brother Oral Roberts, another great soul, and a servant of God. Humble... He hurt hisself while I was there and just going to the platform, he sent for me to come

quickly to pray for him. His knee - he didn't know whether he broke it or what had happened. ...He was one of my converts to Divine healing.²

And while I was praying, the blood veins ran together and made a big "V" on top of his knee. And I laid my hand on top of it and the glory of God fell in his room there and... He got up, come on to the door with me. And a wonderful character... 16

Memorable saying

Watch here: Oral Roberts, a bosom friend of mine, used this Scripture after, I believe he got it from Jeremiah. Jeremiah said, "God is a good God." And my friend, Oral Roberts, has used that many times, that expression, and that's true. God is a good God. 18

And so to the future.....

Billy Graham, Jack Schuller, Oral Roberts, and them preaching the unadulterated Gospel of the Lord Jesus. And people has laughed at them and made fun of it and turned it down flatly. And there's only one thing left; that's Divine judgment, and it's coming.¹⁹



The plane waited for God's Prophet-

~until The coloured woman's prayer was answered~

I had been in Dallas for a meeting and on the way back, the plane got caught in a storm forcing it to make an unscheduled stop in Memphis Tennessee. They took me to that famous hotel there. I went upstairs to bed. And the next morning I got up early, before the sun was up. I was advised that the limousine would pick me up at 8 o'clock and I thought, my, I've got plenty of time; I'll just go down and mail my letters.

Just showing you the sovereign grace of God. I was going down the street singing one of those little pentecostal songs, 'Glad I can say I'm one of them. People in the upper room, full of The Holy Ghost... and what He did for them that day, He'll do for you the same.' and I was going down the street singing it to myself.

And I started to cross the Street and The Holy Spirit said, 'Stop now'. And I thought, 'Now what?' And I turned to the side and I was praying and I said, 'Lord, what would You have me to do?' And He said, 'Turn back now and keep walking.' There He was, that Light whirling. So I just turned and went back and I walked on and on. I looked at my watch — it was 10 minutes to 8. I got way down by the river. I thought, my, this is a coloured district and I walked on singing 'Only Believe — all things are possible, Only Believe'.

I looked out over a coloured person's house which was white washed and there, leaning over the gate was an old Mama, a typical Aunt Jemima with a man's shirt tied around her head. I saw her looking at me and wiping the tears from her eyes, she said, 'Good morning, Parson' And I said, 'How did you know I was a Parson?' She said, 'Well, Parson, when I saw you coming, I knowed you was a Parson.' And she said, 'Did you ever read that story in the Bible about the Shunamite woman who couldn't have any children and Elijah the Prophet went and blessed her that she would have the baby? She promised God she'd raise him for The Lord. Well, I was that kind of woman and I prayed to The Lord and I told Him, if He would give me a child, I would raise him to honour Him and I tried my best to raise him for The Lord. I'm a divorced woman and I'm a washerwoman.

'You know, when my baby got to be a man and a big boy, he got into wrong company and he got a horrible disease. I didn't know it. And he is so far gone that the doctor said he can't live any longer.' She said, 'He's in the house and he's been dying since yesterday. He doesn't know where he's at. He's been groaning since yesterday. I just can't stand to see my baby die.

'That 'baby' was about 180 lbs. Remember, that was 'baby' to a mother. She said. 'I just couldn't stand to see my baby die in that condition. promised The Lord to raise him serve Lord. I prayed all night, last night and I said, 'Lord,



what can I do now?' And so I went to sleep and I dreamed a dream and I saw a man coming with a tan coloured suit on, wearing a tan coloured hat. And The Lord said, 'Here's My Parson'. It was about 3 oclock when I woke up and I've been standing here ever since, waiting for you, and when I saw you coming down the street, you were the same man I saw in the dream and I knowed you were the Parson.'

Then she said, 'Won't you come in?' And she opened up the little gate and I walked into that little coloured person's house that morning. There was no rug on the floor, just a little iron bedhead, but I tell you, if I ever walked into the presence of God, I did there. There were no pin-ups on the wall. There was a little picture hanging over the door, saying, 'God bless our home'. Clean! And I looked around and laying on the little iron bed was a great big husky fellow. He had the quilt in his hand and he was going, 'Hmhm-m' and I said, 'Good morning, young man'. And she said, 'Parson, he don't know nothing. He hasn't known anything for two days. All he talks about is, he's down in the deep sea and it's all dark and he's lost '

And she started crying and she said, 'If I could only hear him say that he was saved, I'd be ready to give him up. It's too far gone. The ulcers have eaten part of his heart out. There's nothing can be done for him.' I said, 'Aunty, do you know what my name is?' She said, 'No Sir, I've never seen you before until I dreamed about you'. I said, 'My name is Branham. I pray for the sick. Did you ever hear me?' She said, 'No Sir, I never did.' I said, 'Will you pray with me?' She said, 'Yes Sir'. And when we knelt down that morning, there in that little humble home, I spent the next few minutes just praying for him.

I've been in some of the grandest homes in the nation, but I never was more welcome than I was in that little shanty that morning. She made me welcome. I knelt down on the floor and I said, 'Aunty, would you lead in prayer?' And she said, 'Yes, Parson'. She prayed a prayer that would make the hair stand on the back of your neck and with tears falling down her face, she prayed, 'God, don't let my baby die. Let him live. If you'll just have my boy tell me he's going to be with Jesus, then when He says this, Mama will be satisfied.' I thought, 'God bless her poor old heart.' She raised up and wiped her eyes. I felt her son's feet. They were so cold and sticky. And he was saying, 'O it's so dark'.

Kneeling, I laid my hands on the boy's feet and I said, "Heavenly Father, here it's after nine o'clock and my plane's gone, and I know You told me to come down here and the only thing I knew to do was just to walk. If this is the place you sent me, I pray You will hear my prayer and will answer this poor old woman." And you know what? He began to say, 'Mama, oh Mama, it's beginning to get light in this room.' And for about five minutes, he was sitting on the bed talking to his Mama.

So I hurried out, called me a cab and got me back to the hotel. And you know what? I rushed over to the airport real quick, just as the plane was making its first call.

For that illiterate coloured woman, God grounded that plane and held it there until her prayer was answered!

(An excerpt from Brother Branham's personal testimony)

About six months later, Brother Branham was travelling by train when it had a short stopover in Memphis Tennessee and he got off to buy a sandwich. People were everywhere, arriving and departing. Amongst the throng was a station worker; a young coloured man. The young man's face suddenly brightened and leaving his cart, he ran up to Bro. Bill calling, "Parson Branham! Parson Branham! You don't remember me, do you?' I said, 'I don't believe I do.'

Remember when your plane was grounded here in Memphis about six months ago and you prayed for that boy who was dying?

I said, 'Are you that boy?'

"Yes Sir, I was healed and I'm a Christian now, Parson Branham!"

Brother Tom Rae's Testimony

Excerpt from ~The Greatest Invitation Ever~

We cannot preach anything we have not experienced. In fact the Prophet taught us, 'Don't preach me a sermon. Live me a sermon.' In the Scriptures, when the Gospel called, men chose land, oxen or marriage over the Gospel. But I believe there are people here who have chosen God over land, oxen and marriage.

I have not hardly spoken of this before. I was a twenty year old man, married and going to the university when I heard the Gospel call. I was told I was nuts, crazy and insane. I was told to never darken the door of that little house that used to be called 'Bibleway House'. But I did not know that God had put a Seed in my soul and when the resurrected Word came by my way, there came an inward pull that I could not stop and I didn't start it. And you can't stop it and you can't stop it.

I was married one week after Ken and Linda were married. The little girl, Shelley, who I had gone to school with, she and I decided to go to university together. We were both going to be teachers. Within a few months she had contracted Crohn's disease and God had started to deal with my life. I started to come to the little house - the little sanctuary - to hear Words of Life that I couldn't hear at university. And I started to see people who were living something that my own soul only longed for.

One night I was taking an evening course. We were both going to S.F.U. and she doubled over. I ended up taking her to Vancouver Hospital. It was a Friday night and I then walked into Bibleway House. A Brother was there who I remember very clearly. Sister Violet was also there and I remember her calling out to God. I walked into this little room with a handful of people around. I wanted God so badly. Brother Byskal was preaching. I responded and gave my heart to The Lord.

I'd gone to Bibleway about ten times, when I told Ken, 'I will not praise The Lord, I will not lift up my hand and I will never say 'Amen'.' Those were the sweetest words I ever ate.

I walked out of there and I ran up my dad's stairs. I still had my long hair and did my deal. I ran into the living room and he said, 'Son, what happened to you?' I said, 'Dad, I got saved. I got saved! I finally got saved, Dad.' He said, 'You're crazy. What are you doing going down there?' I said, 'Well Dad, that's where I feel that God's calling me.' Shelley's parents, they weren't too keen on it, either. They also thought I was crazy. I wanted to be baptized so bad and I wanted to make sure, maybe, that Shelley would be out to watch me being baptized.

When we arrived at the hospital, my Mum and Dad were there. And she was crying and lying in bed there. She looked at me and said, 'Your parents said you are crazy. My parents think you are nuts' I said, 'Well, what about you?' She said, 'Wherever you go I'll go. Your God will be my God and your people will be my people.' I said, 'Okay, I can take the world on now.' I was a twenty year old man. They wanted me to see a psychologist and I said, 'I don't want to see a psychologist. But I went to One and His Name is called Jesus Christ. They yelled, they screamed, they've done everything. I've sat in offices. I've been sworn at and everything at and told not to show up at Bibleway again because I was not the person 'my daughter' married. I said, 'Well I'm definitely not that person. I'm a new person.'

My father showed up at my work at 'Safeway' as I was going to school. I wasn't privileged like Rod, to have a lot of grey matter and I had to do it the hard way. He said, I've got a surprise for you in the car and we went out to the car and Shelley was sitting there. The Doctors had taken out 2/3 the of her large intestine and 1/3 of her small intestine. She was down to 70 pounds. We took her home and put her to bed.

Mike and Marilyn got married that weekend. They wanted Shelley to come to the wedding, but she didn't have enough strength. I came home after the wedding and told her all about it and what a believer's wedding was all about. Something so different to the world that I had been accustomed to.

A few days later her mother had called to take her to buy her more clothes as she was now below 70 pounds. As I looked at her, I said to her Mum, 'Betty, you'd better get in the car. There's something wrong here.' We got her in the car and to the hospital. She'd already passed on when I walked into that emergency room.

I didn't know Bro Ed. He was in Germany. I didn't have a friend in the world. As I walked down the street, I said, 'Lord, You are the only friend I've got.' I didn't know anybody at Bibleway. I didn't know anybody. But I did know one thing — I had met God! You have to look back on your life and know that this hasn't been the call of man, but the Call of God! A twenty year old man walking down the street with people driving by, not having a clue where I'm at.

I was saved on the 15th February and God took Shelley home six weeks later. When we speak about how you have to walk alone with God, we aren't saying it as some nice statement, because your world will be shaken. You've got to know that Blessed are the meek for they shall inherit the earth.

Everything God gives is for our benefit.

When God speaks there has to be a manifestation of that Word. We are the interpretation of that Spoken Word of God. There are more foolish virgins than there are Bride. That's why, throughout every age it's huge and even John said, 'Who is this huge number? Who of those that no man can number?

As Brother Branham said, it was logical to them in order to preserve their truth. God doesn't need to protect His truth. It can protect itself.

According to Brother Branham, The Word of God is the mechanics of God. You have to have it. God can quicken His Word. He gives His Word to the people and then He quickens the people by the Word they receive. In reality He's rapturing The Word. He's not only rapturing this body. Now, He is not only the mechanics, i.e. God's Word. He's the dynamics that prove it.

And if He, Hallelujah!, being the Groom, the Bride has to come forth. The purpose of the manifestation of Christ the Groom, seen in this last day, is to say that the Bride has got to be somewhere. If Christ manifested Himself as Groom in this last day, as Brother Branham said, hunting himself a Bride, if the Groom is here, the Bride's got to be somewhere close. It's so wonderful that God has placed within' us a portion of Himself - to overcome. It is all part of life. We are going to have our gloomy seasons and we are going to have our bright times. It is all a part of life and we all

have times of anxieties and fear. Each one of us goes through that.

But as a son and a daughter of God, I don't have to speak the language of the unbeliever. But you see, sometimes we can choose to speak the language of the unbeliever. And if we speak like them, we may become suicidal like them because we speak their language. And the minute you start to speak their language, let me tell you, Church, then that spirit releases an anointing on you that is negative to you in your situation.

When we are in any situation, let us just speak the good and when I start confessing what is mine, who I am, I want to tell you, the Bible says in Deuteronomy, that 'God's blessing will overcome you'. You don't even have to look for it. God's blessings, brother, they are going to follow you. Hallelujah! You see, God's blessings in His Word are unchangeable, but His blessings are conditional. I do this, God does that. If I walk right, then God is on my side. So there is no changing of His Word.

Deut 28 from vl

1. And it shall come to pass, if thou shalt hearken diligently unto the voice of the Lord thy God, to observe and to do all his commandments which I command thee this day, that the Lord thy God will set thee on high above all nations of the earth.

And all these blessings shall come on thee, and overtake thee, if thou shalt hearken unto the voice of the Lord thy God.

 [Now, listen!] Blessed shalt thou be in the city, and blessed shalt thou be in the field.

4. Blessed shall be the fruit of thy body, and the fruit of thy ground, and the fruit of thy cattle, the increase of thy cattle, the increase of thy kine, and the flocks of thy sheep.

Blessed shall be thy basket and thy store.

6 Blessed shalt thou be when thou comest in, and blessed shalt thou be when thou goest out.

7. The Lord shall cause thine enemies that rise

up against thee to be smitten before thy face: they shall come out against thee one way, and flee before thee seven ways.

Brother, I tell you, this is The Word of The Lord! So if you fight this, you'll fight with God. But this is what I believe. Hallelujah! Amen! So, you watch, Church. If you don't hearken to The Word, He will cause the blessing not to come. But, if we hearken diligently to His Word and live what He tells us and do what He tells us, then Brother, His Word is irrevocable. He cannot change His Word.

And I am so glad to let you know Church, that weeping may endure just for a season. We have been dealing with Joseph and with his life. You see Brother, in Psalm 30:1-5, The Bible said that until His Word came, The Word of The Lord tried Joseph. So whatever Joseph confessed to his brothers, dreaming his dreams i.e. 'Your sheaves will bow before my sheaf", he was confessing and just saying what was in him. Brother, The Bible says that until those things came to pass, The Word of The Lord tried him.

And we said, that whatever you confess to be, that becomes your trial. Whatever you confess. You confess, 'I am a son of God' and the enemy is going to try you on what you said. It tried Jesus. 'If thou be the Son of God - If thou be! - turn those stones into bread.' So he was challenging Him on what Jesus said and what The Word said. So, if The Word says this morning, 'You're a son of God and the daughter of God', no evil will come nigh unto you. But if you start confessing that, then that becomes your trial. That is going to become your trial, because now the enemy is going to try and mend that so that it doesn't come to pass in your life. He's going to hinder you. He's going to put obstacles before you, so that what you have confessed what The Word said about you, he's going to try and stop that from coming to pass. But I've got news for you, devil, this morning. Hallelujah! Whatever God has spoken.

Brother, David said 'The Word of God will perfect that which concerns me'. Whatever concerns me, God will perfect it. So, no matter how the enemy is coming to hinder you from attaining that which God has promised and spoken to you, the devil is too late. He's totally too late. He cannot stop the promise of God. Hallelujah! And as Bro Branham has said, 'unbelief does not stop God. It only stops the unbeliever.' But for the believer, that Word is going to come to pass, Brother. It might take thirteen years like it took Joseph.

When three cyclists stopped to look at this koala, it came up to one of them and put its paws around the boy's leg, needing a drink. And as you see, he got a drink.




Another koala went to a house to try to hide from the heat and to get a bit of shade. Here's what happened when the owner gave him

"The Coming Kingdom" 15th December 2009


Greetings in Jesus name. trust you have a little time spare during this hectic holiday season to rejoice with us in the goodness and

To our dear brothers and sisters in Christ. We greet you in the lovely name of our Lord Jesus Christ at the dawning of a New Year and a new decade. As we consider the many prospects of this coming year, we trust that in some way you will be able to share in the incredible exhilaration of pioneering a spiritual work in the Middle East. Driving down the coast through the cities of Tyre and Sidon, as we did the other day, reminded us again of how surreal our experience is. These are the very cities in which Jesus and Paul ministered. We are in the final days of the Bride's revival. If ever we've felt the spiritual "pull" of the hour, it is NOW.

Neither is it because of trouble, (and there's plenty of it with the anti-aircraft artillery fired last week and another bomb in Beirut a few days ago.) No – it's not for any of these reasons at all. The "pull" of the hour is of a Bride awakening to her Bridegroom's appearing, which for the first time is happening right here in Lebanon and next door in Syria and Egypt. Like some of you, I find myself asking the question; "Why wasn't the prophet allowed to return to Egypt or to Palestine again? Why hasn't a Message work ever been established in the Middle East in the 44 years the prophet was taken off the scene? Why now...?

The challenge of being here is extremely daunting. Considering the magnitude of what needs to be done, humbles us into oblivion. Our efforts seem so small and puny in the light of the immense work that lies before us. Yet we encourage our selves with The Word that plainly declares that this is how the mystery of God is declared; it's God in simplicity. He takes the "nothings" of this world, the poor, the insignificant, and then through our weaknesses proves His Word and power again and again. This is our rest and assurance.

As we gathered last night to bid farewell to 2009 and to welcome the New Year, we did so under the inspiration that we were making "history". Though few in number, we represented for the first time in 2000 years, the promised Bride fulfilling the Word of the Lord in Song of Solomon
