

## ~Thank You, Lord~

Well, another month has gone by, filled with our Lord's mercy and love.

A few weeks ago, we were planning on removing the VERY large pine tree that was previously felled at the end of our section and which had landed half on the cliff and half on the beach, in a most inconvenient position, making it difficult to clear

Just a few days before we shifted the tree from the bottom of our property, [which we anticipated would be a most gruelling time for us], we received a Christian Text Message on our phone, encouraging us to "Trust in the Lord. He will undertake for the problem you are encountering". They did not leave a name.

My wife had prayed for the Lord's help as the day didn't start out at all well, with the weather which was forecast for 'rain and strong winds and bleak temperatures'.

Two of our Christian brothers kindly offered their help and we also hired an Arborist and his friend. The Arborists cut the 1-1/2 metre wide trunk in large pieces that were almost a ton weight, and they fell on the beach. This was the part that we expected would take a large amount of time, with cutting the pieces into smaller sizes, placing them in the wheelbarrow, pushing them along the beach to the 4 wheel drive.

The wood could only be taken through our neighbour's property from the beach to the road. There was no other way. We were grateful that the property owner was willing to allow us to use his property for one day.

But we believe the Lord intervened as the tide was in and the large pieces fell into the water which was calm, as our Lord had changed the weather to fine, calm and pleasant to work in! So the pieces were floating in the sea and our two brothers jumped in the water with just their heads above the water-line, steering the wood pieces to their destination in a few minutes as they enjoyed the cooling water. The others followed suit and we were later informed of their 'refreshing' experience! The project was completed in just a few hours – not the two days that we expected.

We were so thankful to our God Who answers us when we call on Him, as He promised He would. And the tides still obey His Command! The sea was so peaceful and still. I will finish this with a verse from my father's personal favourite hymn.

Wondrous His Power and matchless is His Skill Billows and tempests obey His Sovereign Will! Hushed into silence at His blest 'Peace be Still' ...this Man of Galilee!

## Africa Mission Report

I would like to thank everyone for their prayers during our missionary trip (Brother Richard Oliver and myself) to Kenya, Africa.

Livas invited to teach and introduce the end time message in a city called Kisii in Kenya. Kisii has a population of around three million people and covers a very large area. As far as we know, the Message had never been to this part of Kenya before.

I have personally seen the Lord move supernaturally many times during my life, yet with this trip it seemed the more so in that I felt He was totally in control of every possible detail beyond our own humanity and for this we are very thankful for His leadership and grace. Brother Richard and I both commented together on how it seemed like the book of Acts was being repeated again by the way the Holy Spirit was working to bring His Word to people who had never heard before.

Surely God will get His Word to His elect in some way, as brother Branham said that the work of the Holy Spirit in this age is to get the Truth to the elected seed.

Many ministers were present from as far away as Uganda and other parts of Kenya. For many it was the first time they had heard the Truths of the Scriptures taught in such a way and with such clarity, I saw many faces light up with joy as their understanding was opened to the deeper truths of the Scriptures.

Some of the subjects we touched on were, "The Opened Book" - how that Daniel was told to seal up the Book until the time of the end. Paul said that "we see through a dark glass (not a clear understanding) but then (at a future time) we would see face to face". John was told to seal it up until the end time, and at the sounding of the seventh angel's voice, the understanding of the Word would be opened, and then the mystery of the entire Bible would be revealed and make Christ known in all His wonder and beauty of character.

We also spoke on "The God Head", "Serpent Seed", "The End Time Messenger", and "A Word Birth by

the Incorruptible Seed", showing that the emphasis is on the seed (Word of God) and not the anointing, because the rain (Holy Spirit) will fall on both true and false seed, and both will rejoice and praise the Lord. Therefore it is the Seed and not the Holy Spirit anointing that determines whether the person is a child of God or not.

Many of these truths that we understand so well were brand new to these people. It was a pleasure to preach and Teach the Word to such hungry minds and hearts.

Thank you all again for your many prayers and support for this trip. There is still much work to be done in these places, and we will continue to trust the Lord for His continued leadership to help us to perform His Will for the bride of Christ in Africa and abroad.



## A Love For The Truth

#### Bro. Tim Pruitt - Pt 2

Nothing compares to the Promise I have in You! Nothing compares! Now, notice again. This is not a repeat of Pentecost, but a continuation of the Book of Acts. It's again 'I will restore. I am going to put forth a new branch, and when it does she will write a new book of Acts.' But the book of Revelation shows how the antichrist [exposes his work]. How the anti-Christ would come into the church and defile it, making it lukewarm, formal and powerless. It exposes Satan, revealing his works, the attempted destruction of Gods people and the discrediting of Gods Word right down to the time he is cast into the lake of fire. He fights that. He cannot stand it. He knows that if the people get the TRUE REVELATION OF THE TRUE CHURCH AND WHAT SHE IS, AND WHAT SHE STANDS FOR, AND THAT SHE CAN DO THE GREATER WORKS, SHE WILL BE AN INVINCIBLE ARMY' Hallelujah!

Now that's an army that has got a passion. There is a drive in them and we'll not be defeated. This thing will not overcome me. Now this is an evil spirit attacking me and he attacked the complex within my body and I find it hard to forgive but I am going to rise up above that thing. I'm going to possess the gate of that enemy. I'm not going to live and be high tempered, making excuses, I've got the Holy Ghost. I can't overcome that, but the Holy Ghost can. That's a Son of God. Come on. As a son of James and Loretta Pruitt I can't overcome that, but as a Son of God I'm an overcomer.

I can rise above that thing. I can defeat that thing. Hallelujah! Because I am a continuation of the actions of the Holy Spirit in a believer. That right? Amen. Not somebody got about this much compassion you know, and come to Church and somebody hurts their feelings and back out they go again. Come on! Grow up. Come back to realize you need to start right here. Go a little further with God this morning. Realize I've got a need of Christ in my life. I can't continue to let that thing defeat me. I can't continue to live with that problem, it's death. Now he will definitely be as definitely thwarted today as when Christ withstood him (just as thwarted, just as defeated). The Bible says that I'm going to overcome as Christ overcame. Is that right? That's Laodicea! Listen, he can't put it in the Word and then nobody can do that. If He put it in the Word then somebody has to do that. They will overcome as Christ overcame. How do you overcome as Christ did? By Christ living in you.

Now he says, Satan hates revelation but we love it. WITH TRUE REVELATION IN OUR LIVES THE GATES OF HELL CANNOT PREVAIL AGAINST US, BUT WE WILL PREVAIL OVER THEM.

You will recall that I mentioned at the beginning of this message that this book we are studying is THE ACTUAL REVELATION

OF JESUS HIMSELF IN THE CHURCH AND HIS WORK IN THE FUTURE AGES. Then I mentioned that it takes the Holy Spirit to give us



revelation or we will fail to get it." And that's why, people, you can never see the Kingdom of God unless you are born again. I see it, Brother Tim. I see correct baptism. Listen you can never see it. You might assimilate the knowledge and get an intellectual understanding. Well, this is the way you know, Father, Son and Holy Ghost. That's not the correct way. The Lord Jesus Christ is the correct way. Oh I know it, now I got it.

Listen! Do you know what it means to be baptized? It means to die to sin, become as dead as 12 o'clock midnight, that the old life is dead, never to live again, and we are burying it, and it has a resurrection. Hallelujah! A resurrection on the inside of you. That is Christ raised from the dead. You've raised from the dead, not to live the same old dirty life, but to live an overcoming victorious life Amen. The actual revelation of Jesus Himself in the Church and His work in the future ages and I mention it takes the Holy Spirit to give us revelation or we will fail to get it. Bringing these two thoughts together you will see that it won't take just ordinary study and thinking to make this Book real. It is going to take the operation of the Holy Ghost.

That means this Book can't be revealed to anyone, but a special class of people. He said "I have hid these things from the eyes of the wise and the prudent, and have revealed them unto babes." Why babes? They've been born again. Unless you have been born again, it'll never be revealed to you. You can know all about it, you can quote quotes and everything else but it never comes alive to you. Never becomes real. Amen. Now, this Book means it can't be revealed to anyone but a special class of people. That's why some sitting by on the same pew will get it and the other one can't. One thinks he's got it and he did. He got intellectual understanding, but the life of it is never there. God wants to give you the life of it. Amen. Spirit and truth. This is what it requires to make you a true worshipper. You're not going to be just a worshipper.

Come on. Which is truth? Now, watch again.. "It will require the ability to hear from God." (That's not just Brother Branham, that's YOU) "It will require supernatural instruction, not just a student comparing verse with verse, though that's good. But a mystery requires the teaching of the Holy Spirit or it can never become clear. How we need to hear from God and lay ourselves open and become yielded to the Spirit to hear and know." Amen.



## Middle East: Contending for The Faith

Greetings once again in Jesus name. In the brief epistle written by Jude we are urged to "...earnestly contend for the faith which was once delivered unto the saints." This is a constant for any believer – anytime and anyplace, especially for us as we live in this Laodecian age of soft living and instant gratification. Our challenge is to be on constant guard lest we fall prey to the comforts of life.



This of course is also true in the spiritual context. While incalculable good and supernatural works can be accomplished in a moment of faith at the hearing of the Word, there is an arduous labour in developing our spiritual character. Planting, teaching and establishing

new believers is not something that one can measure on a graph or even a calendar. I'm reminded of the great missionary and apostle to India, William Carey and how he labored for nearly <u>6 years</u> before seeing the fruits of even *one soul* accepting the Lord Jesus as their Saviour.

What then is – *or should be* our perspective concerning the labours of mission's work? Is it instant results? Are we expecting people to merely repeat "I believe God sent a prophet..." - like some card-carrying or message book waving member? Is it to get people to a new doctrine, a new church or to the Lord Jesus Christ?

What is the criteria that constitutes the honor and respect of being identified as a true believer in these last days? Is it not of bringing one into a deep spiritual relationship with the person of Christ, not merely in "letter form", but of being baptized with His transforming power through the restored Word? The faith we have received transcends all languages, cultures and societies. It is the life power of One from a heavenly dimension. Being born again and filled with His Spirit, we no longer retain our earthly nationality nor culture, but are transformed into the citizens of a Holy nation, a Royal Priesthood.

Let us not forget Brother Branham's exhortation; "What are we trying to do, anyhow, are we trying to establish our church or are we trying to establish the Word of God? What are we trying to do? Where we working at? Are we trying to get the people back into This...?"

This is especially important when pioneering a work in a virgin, unreached area. Faith and the standards the Word requires must not and cannot be compromised. Anything built or established on a "hybrid message" mixed with man's ideas will surely fail. Thus the temptation to be quick to attach a label of "believer" for the sake of showing results, or of making spectacular "reports", must be resisted at all costs. Regardless of how many – or how few respond, our duty and responsibility is to contend for and uphold all the standards in doctrine and conduct. This, as James wrote of our husbandman, requires patience as He "...waiteth for the precious fruit of the earth, and hath long patience for it..."



**Israel:** As we consider Israel, a believer's eyes never stray far from this prophetical "time-clock". Their acts of possessing the land along with the spiritual awakening

that is unfolding, is a clear indicator of the days in which we live. Yet, as we await Israel's spiritual rebirth through the two witnesses of Rev. 11, we can easily overlook the fact that there is also the potential for a "Gentile" ministry before this happens. One must not overlook the fact that excluding the West Bank and Gaza, the population of Israel includes over 20% of Arabs . These are precious souls who also need to hear of

the life saving Message of truth that has come in these last days. Should we not anticipate a time when the Lord opens doors of ministry among some Arab's in Israel? Please join us in prayer as we seek the Lord's will and direction in this matter.



**Syria:** The tensions and prospects for an all-out war in Syria are rising dramatically. Not "if", but when this happens, Israel will most certainly be attacked. Thus, the

volley of Katyusha rockets launched into the Galilee region of northern Israel on Tuesday, Nov 29th by Syria's ally in South Lebanon, comes as no surprise and serves as an indicator of things to come.

Unprecedented events are happening in the Arab world. On Monday, Nov 28th, the Arab League of Nations, for the first time ever, implemented severe economic sanctions against another member state - Syria. Syria's Foreign Minister, Walid al-Moualem, called the Arab League's decision as a "declaration of economic war". With tensions mounting, a recent report cites military officers from NATO and Persian Gulf nations establishing a mixed operational command in Turkey, close to the border of Northern Syria.

Adding to this buildup of military power in the Middle East, was the arrival of a US Naval aircraft carrier taking position just off the coast of Syria. This was an obvious counter to the Russian Warships already in position in the Syrian port city of Tartus - scarcely more than 80 miles from Cyprus. This prospect of all out war in Syria of course causes us immense concern, not only for those in Israel, but especially for those with whom we have been sharing the Message in Syria.



**<u>Bahrain:</u>** Your prayers will be appreciated as I will be traveling to minister the Word of God in Bahrain in December. This is the tiny island kingdom in the Persian

Gulf bordering Saudi Arabia. A Brother from the Philippines moved there to start an outreach work among the workers there. By God's grace souls are being saved and a work established that is reaching out to others in Bahrain.
