



It is brother-translator, Alex Gnezdilov from Russia.

I have been a Message-believing Christian for ten years already. For several years I have been translating sermons of brother Branham's into Russian and if some English-speaking ministers come into our area, I am helping with translation.

In June of last year brother Paul Moffitt from Stratford, Taranaki, New Zealand, has visited Ukrainian city Donets, which is very close to the place I am living in, and have ministered in Donetsk church of The Lord Jesus Christ. He may tell you more about our fellowship and experiences. In January of this year brother Vladimir Ryabov - pastor from Donetsk, Ukraine and five more brothers have visited New Zealand and have preached in brother Malcolm Wano's and in brother Paul Moffitt's Tabernacles.

I have one request which may look unusual and I trust you may help me with it. There is one brother-minister who lives in Russian city, Orenburg and who is pastoring a church over there. His name is Evgeny (Eugene) Iakovlev and for six years, he has been visiting Sakhalin Island and ministering there to deaf and dumb Message believers. I have know him not too long but I can see the results of his ministry in Orenburg, in Sakhalin and in city Khabarovsk which is not far from Sakhalin and there is also a group of deaf and dumb believers which came together during his ministry to them. All this looks unbelievable but it was done to fulfill prophesy and to find every predestined seed even among deaf and dumb people.

This brother has asked me to contact other brothers who have more information to find out and to share with him contacts of believers and ministers of groups or churches in Japan, who believe or wish to believe the same Message, to make contact and to minister over there if they will need his ministry in their midst. I am ready to be his translator and mediator if the Lord wishes to use both of us in Japan for His Glory and for His Japanese Bride.

From my side I wish to mention that brother Eugene's life, testimonies and sermons are unlike any other you have heard of. He has really genuine and unusual gifts to bring the Revealed Word of the present Truth, uncorrupted and in a simple way. May the Lord honour this desire of his, and my souls, and will provide the way for his Word.

Actually Japan is real close to Sakhalin or Khabarovsk, even more closer than to any other spot on the map. And there is not only air connection but also the water way.

So I will wait for any actual information about contacts of Message believers who live in Japan. Any place and any amount of believers.

May the Lord abundantly bless your ministry and you personally.

Profile of a French Missionary in New Caledonia

Last year Bro Francois Le Picard, a French speaking pastor and missionary from Switzerland, put me in contact with another French speaking missionary living in Reunion Island off the east African coast who is doing a work in New Caledonia. This brother's name is **Pastor Alex Hoarau**. His ministry has largely been amongst the Moslem people of the Comoros and Madagasgar regions and the Lord has wonderfully used his ministry to bring many Moslems to the message. Bro' Alex visited me at my home in NZ for a week and I joined him on one of his trips to New Caledonia from the 3rd of February to the 11th. [Bro.Alex Hoarau baptizing Sis. New Caledonia is one of the few islands in the Pacific basin that has not accepted the message of the hour. It is a French protectorate and is spiritually mainly under the umbrella of the Roman Catholic Church with a number of smaller Protestant churches spread around the island. Bro Alex has been to New Caledonia 5 times over the past few years making contacts with various people in the denominations as well as people he has come across in his travels. From this he has carefully and wisely made inroads into the hearts of the few that have realized that they have been starved of the truth by the religious systems they have been held captive to. New Caledonia is a place where strategy must be used as it is very difficult to bring anything new into this nation because of the spirit overshadowing the minds of the people.

Noumea, the capital of this island is a modern tourist haven and the pacific regions own **Sodom**. Except for the tourists, very few people speak English so it is by necessity that a French speaking missionary has gone onto this island. The cultural mindset and the French language seem to be so tightly interwoven that it is difficult for an Anglo to gain a foothold there.

Bro Alex hired a car and we headed north away from the capital into the rural areas. Here you meet the native Kanake people who are of Melanesian origins. They are racially the similar to what you find in Vanuatu and P.N.G but the spirit over them makes interacting with them much more difficult. They are fearful of anything that is new and it is by Bro Alex's careful approach to them that he has little by little found a way into their hearts. To come out of the Roman Catholic Church is to risk having your house burnt down and in one case this previously happened to a widowed lady that has since been exposed to the message of the

hour. Whilst at this sister's new home beside the sea in Hiengeng we had three meetings and Bro Alex was able to baptize another sister in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ. Please pray for Claudi and Victoria as they are living in a threatening environment. Bro Alex has distributed the message via books and CD's in French to his contacts, giving them a foretaste of more to come. On the CD's Bro Branham is speaking in his Kentucky English then Bro Francois Le Picard translates each sentence into French. They are a blessing to listen to.

Over the next few days Bro Alex met up with many more of his contacts and also preached in a denominational church. But I



want to outline to the readers his vision for the next 8 months.

In Bro' Alex's own words, "the walls of Jericho are crumbling". But they need to be completely destroyed. In October he is planning a convention in Noumea to round up all his contacts and bring to them a full exposure to the message of the hour. This is going to take a huge amount of preparational work.

My desire is for everyone to support this brother that is carrying the baton in that country. New Caledonia is Bro Alex's work that the Lord has placed on his heart, but to get behind him will make his work that much easier. The convention will be the biggest outworking of the Lord in the history of New Caledonia and he wishes for as many brethren around the world to come and support it with their presence. He especially asks that as many young people as possible come so that they can display their love for the Lord to the youth in this nation. Over the next few months I will be keeping the BNL readers up to date with news concerning this convention and I kindly ask the pastors to let their congregations know about these meetings. Please plan early if you want to partake and I will give the definite dates as Bro' Alex passes further information onto me.

Sister Alissa Walker tells of her happy visit to Vanuatu

This was my first trip to Vanuatu, and it was easy to see why so many keep coming back to this beautiful country. Lush tropical vegetation and the happiest, most welcoming people I have ever met, yet most beautiful of all was to see and witness the wondrous work the Lord is doing in the hearts of His Bride.

The convention began on Sunday, 15th January and our excitement mounted as our little plane made a surprisingly smooth landing on the grass runway of Pentecost Island. At first, the rugged isolation of the island seemed an unlikely location for a convention of international proportions, yet one look at the sea of smiling faces and we knew we were in the right place. Most of the village children had walked to the airport to greet us, and the first thing that struck me – it was how amazingly happy they were. These same joyous children shouldered our luggage, and we began the 20-minute hike along the narrow muddy track uphill to the village of Anvenvene. Below: The Ministers of convention.



Once in the village, we were met by more warm smiles from the villagers, including Bro Paul Hinge, the pastor of the local assembly. The believers here are very sweet and humble, and made us feel like honoured guests. Most spoke English fluently, and we acquired a few words in Bislama along the way as well. The language barrier was barely noticeable with the children, who were thrilled to have special visitors. They took great joy in showing us around, singing for us and posing for photos, all the while giggling at everything we did. Right: Church meeting

Bro Paul and his team made sure the visitors were comfortably accommodated with purpose built bungalows, bathrooms, and a kitchen hut. The wonderful meals were catered for by the



sisters, and the brothers provided the meat by killing calves and spear fishing. On the last day, we had a huge feast in the main kitchen hut with all of the believers. We were very blessed by their warmth and hospitality, and the humble way in which they insisted on giving us their best.

The meetings were the highlight of the convention, and alternated between two and three meetings per day. With no clocks or watches, we knew it was time for the meeting to start when we heard the music begin to play, calling the people to begin filing into the church. The Vanuatu people have a unique musical rhythm and there was such a sweet atmosphere as the worship began to rise.

Bro Adrian Gray of Taranaki, NZ, took three meetings, preaching on the Light that has come for the Bride, and the battle that comes as a result. Bro Malcolm Ferris from Christchurch, NZ, took two meetings, speaking on judgement and the whole armour of God. Bro Johnny Dimov from Perth, Western Australia, took five meetings and spoke on a number of subjects including the Godhead and deliverance from the law.

Four local ministers - Bro William Frank, of Port Vila, Bro Pethuel from Ambrym, Bro Randall and Bro Cyril from Santo -- took meetings, preaching in their native language, Bislama. Although I had never heard the language before, I was still able to understand the majority of the sermons. I was amazed at the quality of ministry coming from these brothers. Through my limited understanding of Bislama, it was very evident they weren't just repeating something they had heard, but the revelation of this Message was planted deeply in their hearts. There was a reality that had transformed their lives, showing that this isn't the work of man, but the work of the Lord.

Believers continued to arrive on planes and boats throughout the convention. Some of our friends from Australia and New Zealand



left on Wednesday, partway through the convention, and the rest headed back to Port Vila on Sunday, after a total of 17 meetings over the week. There were a number of baptisms throughout the convention, and a baby dedication.

Keep Praying for our Brother

Youcef Nadarkhani, an Iranian pastor who in 2010 was found guilty of apostasy and sentenced to death for refusing to recant Christianity, may have received a final execution order, according to the American Center for Law and Justice and Fox News.



Neither Human Rights Watch nor Amnesty International could verify the information for The Huffington Post, but the White House on Thursday afternoon (23rd Feb) issued a statement condemning the reports and calling on Iran to release Pastor Nadarkhani.

"This action is yet another shocking breach of Iran's international obligations, its own constitution, and stated religious values," the White House statement read. "The United States stands in solidarity with Pastor Nadarkhani, his family, and all those who seek to practice their religion without fear of persecution -- a fundamental and universal human right."

While unable to verify the reports, Faraz Sanei, the Iran researcher at Human Rights Watch, spoke with The Huffington Post in a telephone interview about the uncertain circumstances surrounding Nadarkhani.

"A death sentence that has been sent for implementation by the judiciary would suggest the person is at imminent risk of execution," Sanei said. "If it has been sent to the implementation department, that is very troubling."

Sanei added that if the implementation has indeed been sent, Nadarkhani is "one step closer" to being executed.

When He the Spirit of Truth is come

Hallelujah! Praise His Name! If you would open your Bibles to John 16:7-13.

- 7. Nevertheless, I tell you the truth; it is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you, but if I depart, I will send Him unto you.
- 8. And when He is come, He will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgement:
- 9. Of sin, because they believe not on me;

I found in recent months and in the last few years especially, it's been beneficial for me to be able to give a summary of what God has laid on my heart and put it in a few distilled and concise statements. So I will do that again this morning, as I move through the various quotes that we have.


I would like to just rehearse and review these statements. We are well acquainted with these statements. We've heard many times that 'The Word comes to the Prophet'. I'm happy it does. It doesn't come to a great theological school, but 'The Word comes to the Prophet' and the Spirit comes to The Word.

Now, those of you who question and wonder about your Baptism of the Holy Spirit, I want to settle this today for you. The Spirit comes to The Word. He is the Author of The Word. And it's not like some single great explosive experience that has been taught by Pentecost or some of the Denominations as such. But if you hear The Word...

Now you hear about Pentecost. Don't forget, prior to the day of Pentecost, those disciples heard His Word – heard His Word – heard His Word for two or three years, and then ended up on the day of Pentecost and He told them, "Go up to Jerusalem and tarry in Jerusalem. The Bible said that He was seen of above 500 brethren, but only 120 got to the Upper Room. 380 didn't make it, for whatever reason. They had other things that they were occupied with, as we would today.

But of the 120 that got there, Jesus hadn't ever made or stressed on any of the disciples, 'Peter, you be sure and be there. You must be there. And the others, James and John, you especially. You were with me on the Mount. You were here and you were there and you were with Me in the Garden of Gethsemane. You must be there.'

No, He just threw the Word out like He's doing today; like He's done for many years. He throws the Word out and for some, it just seems more than it does for others. And for some, they do something with it. If you take the Word into an honest and sincere heart, I would say one thing to you: The Holy Ghost will come to that Word. He is the baptizer. Whether you have an emotion or you don't have an emotion – I don't know what



So I want to start out by – we always get a best view in the beginning in Eden, in Genesis. The first man was a Spirit man. If you can just remember these things as we more through. Angelic Visitations

Extracts from the sermon "The Forty days after the Resurrection" preached 1st August 2010.

....How many of you looking for the dead in Christ? Now is there something that we can see before we see those? I've already gone through this thing of the angels with you and there's nine places in the Gospels where Jesus told the parables about the angels that God will send. They'll bring a trumpet, or the great noise or that will gather. He's going to send His angels, but if you don't believe in angels. I'm sorry if you're one of those who don't believe in angels but you'll never have the book of Acts repeated unless you believe in angels because if you take the book of Acts and you take the actions of the angels out of there - you don't have anything happening......

Now why is it that we don't have angels in our lives, in our homes in our churches? There's 1067 quotes about them in Brother Branham's messages. Brother Branham gives us the answer - it's because we don't live a life where they're welcome. But how many scriptures and quotes would I have to read you where he says, they're here today sitting by you in the pew, they were with you in the car this morning and they kept that car from hitting you, they were there when the food barrel was empty.

You see, we don't recognise them..... But if you don't believe in angels... one could sit down right by you. Now if you got a picture [in your mind], well it's a halo and wings - you'll never see that. But I believe that every one of us at some time in our life has had an encounter with angelic beings. If you're a believer and a Christian, the odds are just that you've had that experience. Now if you'll take and read those quotes, Brother Branham said, it could be in a neighbour, you thought it was just the grocery man.

Brother Branham started naming off the characteristics you'll see him with. He said, somebody just come up and start being kind to you, he said that's the reason you should be kind to everybody. You say well if I knew he was a man of God. If I knew... and I know him, and I've judged him, and he believes just like I believe - then I will be nice to him, otherwise I'll have nothing to do with him. You might get a shock some day, someone might suddenly rip his robe off and say "look here at my wings, turn the light on you'll see my halo". What I'm talking to you about I believe there's a reality to a dimension here. And there should be a purpose for it..... Right now I don't believe you can communicate with the dead in Christ. Brother Branham said that's spiritualism.

But I do believe that right now at this time we can begin to have the angelic visitations...Now I don't know if I've ever said this to where it impressed you enough to remember it, but I think I've mentioned it a number of times. Something I personally observed when I was with Brother Branham, like for example if we had lunch, and I didn't care where we were, if we were in a meeting or something, when it got to be 2 o'clock....

The first time it happened, I remember we were in a restaurant and it came 2 o'clock, and the restaurant was in the motel we were staying at. And Brother Branham just pushed his chair back, and didn't even say goodbye. He just got up and left. Well I reviewed, "did I say something", or "was Brother Branham uncomfortable

with this?" But he left, and I begin to notice, every day around 2 o'clock Brother Branham got up and left us, and we never saw anymore of him until the meeting. And that's when Billy went to his room and got him

to bring him in there. But let's see if we can do something about that. I think I found a quote let's look at 1956, April 5th p22 JESUS AROSE CHICAGO IL THURSDAY 56-0405

E-22 While they were thinking on these things, a Stranger walked out. That's usually...?... That's when you want to get... When you go to thinking about Him, that's when He appears. They were talking about Him when He appeared. And that's the reason, maybe, He doesn't appear to so many of us. We talk too much about other things instead of about Jesus. Maybe we're talking about trading cars, something else, or the washing, what kind of soap powder do you use, listening to the radio and some kind of nonsense. That's the reason He doesn't appear. If we'd just keep our minds on Him...

"Let the meditation of my heart." He told Joshua, He said, "Mediate on these things day and night." David said, "I'll bind Them on my bed post." Sure. Let Them stay in, inside of you and think of Them, mediate upon Them.

Do you ever notice how the Angel of the Lord comes? Of an evening at three o'clock when I go in, I close everything out, don't let no one come in, and just set there and read the Word, and yield myself until I know He's there. I can feel it when He's coming. He comes in, and I know He's there. Oh, my. That's the way you do. That's the way the disciples did. They were with one place in one accord in an upper room. And they were all up there praising Him. And all of a sudden He came in. That's the way He does it.

Now when Brother Branham got up and left us at 2 o'clock, where was he headed? It was to his room. That's what he practiced..Do you folks remember a few months ago that this was something the Lord had put on my heart to do? How many of you know of my practice? I go to my office. When I shut myself away, the presence of the Lord comes. That's when I begin to have these experiences.

I cannot explain them to you. I cannot tell you what to do. I only can tell you what I've shared and it's from this observation and personal practice that I can tell you. We need to meditate on the Lord. Draw nigh to God and He will draw nigh to you. Now if you go in to seek something so you can come out and brag about it and so forth, then I'll question your experience. You wont get the anointing and the blessing out of it that you should get....And folks, the last three visitations and discussions I've had, not even thinking about it, have been about 2012.




