

someones house). They also are blessed with an abundance of piano players. Other activities they like to do together are volleyball, softball, board games and of course eating is one of their favourites.


One very unique thing about this group of young

First of all I would like to thank you so very much for the effort you put forth for the youth, God bless you all. As I got the last Y.Q. and was reading the testimonies and letters I felt very strongly that the Lord was leading me to write in my testimony. I had all intentions of doing it the next day, but the more I thought about it the less I wanted to do it. I kept putting it off and saying, later. I also was making up excuses for not being able to do it. But, it kept coming back to me an couldn't get away from it any longer. I don't know if this will help someone else, or if it's just for me. I know that the Lord has a reason for everything.

When I was ten or eleven I went to church on Sunday's with my Grandmother to the House of Faith, where Michael Severt, pastors. I really enjoyed it, but as I got older I lost interest and quit going. A year or two went by and I finally got to Junior High School, I thought it was really great. I said to myself, "This is where you really start to grow up." Boy, was I wrong. In the 7th grade, 12 years old, I had my first experiences with cigarettes, beer, marijuana, and speed. I look at 12 year olds now and it seems too hard to imagine someone that young being involved in such things. Fortunately, it really didn't stick with me right then.

When I got into high school that's when the real problems started. I had a crowd. During my freshman year, for 2 months I took at least 2 hits of speed everyday. I was, what they call a "speed freak." After a while that quit giving me the effect I wanted, so I got heavier into marijuana. I found that everything I wanted was very much available at school. I was so unhappy. My life at home was so bad, I just wanted to anyway anytime I got the chance. Things of course got worse. In October 1984, at 15, I ran away for the first time. This really showed my rebellious spirit. I came home the next day, but in even worse condition. In January 1985 I ran away again. I didn't return to my home until 4 months later. I was in West Virginia and I found myself getting into even more trouble. I thought I knew it all. I didn't want anyone to tell me anything. When I did finally return to Dayton I found my father had started to go to church at the House of Faith. I thought that was great for him, but I didn't want to have anything to do with it. When I found out that I had to go to church on Sundays, I was furious! When I did go out I really

began to drink heavily. I thought that was the only happiness in the world to get high and/or drunk. In the summer '86 I was invited to go to Washington State and California with a family I had babysat for. I was really excited wanted to go desperately. My parents had talked with me about Youth Camp, but I had no desire to go whatsoever. So they told me I couldn't go West unless I went to Youth Camp. I was upset, but I wanted to go on vacation so badly, I decided to suffer through Little did camp that that would be the happiest week of my life. The day after I got home from vacation I left for Youth Camp '86. The first day of camp I really got to know the people that I was sharing a cabin with. I will never forget those girls, because they made such an impression on me, which proves that living a Godly life is a testimony in itself. They were so content and had such a peace in their life I had never experienced. The 2nd nights service was the turning point in my life. The speaker was teaching on some things that really shook me, especially the parts on rock music. Up until that point, my life centered around rock-n-roll. I did everything possible listening to that music. I realized that night that Satan was so pleased with

me for doing exactly what he wanted me to do and Jesus was crying for me to come and live for him and let him take care of all my troubles and worries. As I sat there I knew that there would be an alter call and my mind and heart were struggling against each other. A thousand things keep going through my mind. I thought about the things I would have to give up and what my friends would say. But my heart was in torture because it longed for the peace that I saw Christians with and I knew that that could only come from one place, Jesus Christ. I knew what I had to do. I went to that alter and gave it all to Jesus When I got up I felt that if someone didn't tie me to the ground, I was going to float off. I had a true genuine peace that rock music, drugs, and all the other things of the world couldn't give me. But after all is said and done what does a life like that have to speak of? Eternal life is Joy unspeakable and full of glory. There's a peace that passes all human understanding. Why would the world not want this mysterious peace?

There is a certain time that God strives with a man. When someone was witnessing to me, they would say, "Tom you better get in while the waters are moving."

I didn't understand that till now. But I am thankful that he called me and allowed me to get in and be made whole.

The only difference between this man and myself was that he was troubled thirty-eight years, and I was only troubled for twenty-one. He would try to work when the water was moving, but couldn't

because he was too weak. The same applied to me.

At the age of six years I couldn't understand why my parents sent me to Sunday School when they didn't go to church. Yet I always had a desire for the things of God.

At sixteen years we moved. I had good parents - the best that society could give. They gave me love, money, but they couldn't give me the peace of God.

I was the type to fit into any crowd. I would be grease ball with the greasers, a jock with the sports guys. I was what you call a real Jacob - a goody, goody guy. Then there came a time in my life where the peer pressure was just too great.

A certain friend always tried to persuade me to smoke dope. At first I would touch it then started wondering about it. I still didn't want anything to do with it.

One day I went into the room and got the old Bible that mom hid. I started reading John 1:1 "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God." I went through the creation, then the Bible started getting too deep. I got down on my knees and prayed "Lord if you ever show yourself to me, I'll live the rest of my life for you."

Time went on, and the devil fights harder once a stand has been made, and having nothing to stand on, sin increases and moral standards go down. If you're in the world you watch your parents. You see how their standards change through the years. Children always watch that leadership.

The pressure got too great and I fell. I neverdid anything half way. It was all the way or not at all. I was doing more dope in one week than my friends were doing in two months. At school I was stoned, obviously not proud of myself at all.

At the age of seventeen I would ask our Baptist youth leader questions, and he couldn't answer. He told me God would reveal it in time. I was not satisfied with that answer.

In school you have idols, but there was no one I wanted to be like. I

couldn't fit in. I was always the life of the party, but went home wondering if there wasn't a better way, and if there wasn't anything else.

Going from junior to senior high I remember Sister Linda Byskal. (Bro. Ed Byskal's daughter). Ken liked Linda and she would witness to him. At a party on a Friday night Linda came and kind of bound the whole place. No one could get wild. As soon as Linda came in something lit up. Linda started witnessing to Ken and me. We were listening in the shadows, but we were both stirred. I told Linda that I would like to talk to her Dad and she told me that he would be glad to talk to me. I imagined her dad to be like the people at the United Church where I went with a white collar and a baldish head. Linda called every night that week and said her dad would like to talk with me. Every night I found some excuse, until I finally told Linda that I was not ready. How I wish that I would have given my life over to Christ then.

We went on through school. I was going with a girl that was a close friend to Linda. Ken got saved and everyone thought that was only because he liked Linda. I knew that Ken had what I wanted, so I watched and saw that the life that he now had was what I desired.

Every chance Ken and Linda had they told me that I needed to get saved and explained the way to me. I told Ken when the Lord deals, i'll come.

The young lady that I was going with was a very good friend of Linda's when she was sixteen, she started attending Bible Way. God was dealing with me and I told her it was either me or them. We got married, and Ken and Linda got married. Everytime they came over they witnessed to us. He was everything that I wanted, but I was missing it for drink, popularity, and school. We were both in university. I failed almost every course that year because of drinking. My second year I realized that I had to pull my act together. I pulled up from failing to

second class. I had a home, a car, everything I needed and I put God behind, I knew there was a calling in my life, so I decided to find out about all these religions. I took a course to get right into it. Brother Ken kept inviting me to come to Bible Way, so I finally went. I saw people I had never seen before. God had changed them. I wanted what they had but I couldn't obtain it. I saw people actually lived what they professed. I went back about ten times. My wife got sick and was taken to the hospital where it was diagnosed that she and a disease of the lower intestines. This was a disease that only three persons in America had. I quit school and started working full-time at a Safeway Store. God really started to deal with me during that time. My parents and her parents started giving me static. Through surgery they removed three quarters of my wife's large intestine and half of her small intestine. One night at Bible Way they took a

One night about one and a half years after Ken started witnessing to me I asked him why God hadn't come since I had asked Him. I could see he was wondering what he hadn't told me. At this point he told me that God sent a prophet and opened up the serpent seed. That night Ken showed me the Word and I saw why the world is in the state it is. I knew that I was lost and that I needed Him.

I told Ken that I would accept Him, but couldn't go to the altar, couldn't raise my hand, and couldn't praise God. But God led me exactly where I didn't want to go. A few nights later I heard Brother Ed preach and he asked who wanted to get saved. I raised my hand and went to the alter. That night God lifted my load. I didn't have to say anything when I got

home, they knew I had been to Bible Way.

He asked me to go into his study. He came against me for various things. We're all Christians, you don't have to go to that little church, was what he told me. This hurt, but seeing I was staying in his house I thought that I better abide by what he said. Sunday Shelly told me I didn't have to prove that I loved her, she knew that I did. I could go to church, but I didn't go. Tuesday came around, time for another service but again I didn't go. Wednesday morning I looked at Shelly and she just didn't look right. I told her mom to take her to a doctor. The doctor sent us to a hospital. By the time we got there she was unconscious. My desire was that whatever the Lord's will was, I wanted it no matter what the consequences were. The Lord took Shelly home and I thought "Lord, it's you and me."

At the cemetery I saw a group of people over to the right side with their heads bowed. I knew they were praying for me.

Peter 1.7 says "That

the trial of your faith, being more precious than of gold that perisheth, though it be tried with fire, might be found unto praise and honour and glory at the appearing of Christ." I'm so thankful that he called me as that man in the scripture. I was lost in a state of confusion. I was in that state such a long time. Jesus knew the man at the pool had been in that case a long time. I had been in my case a long time and I wanted so much to be delivered of that. The Bible says "Wilt though be made whole." Brother Branham teaches us that we are a free moral agent. God gives us each a decision. Wilt thou be made whole; wilt thou be born again, wilt thou give your heart to me? This man didn't have strength. He needed Jesus



Spiritual Food To Feed On

John 15:4

Abide in me and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, except it abide in the vine; no more can ye, except ye abide in me.

Truly this scripture says a mouthful. If he is the vine and we are the branches, we cannot receive strength to bear fruit unless we are ever abiding in the vine which is Christ. What does it mean to abide? It means to remain, to stay or to dwell. It means to continue. If we continue to receive strength from him, we will bear fruit automatically. How do we receive strength? By feeding on spiritual food. Where is spiritual food? Only in the word of God. Thus, if we abide in His Word we can receive strength to grow and live the life of Christ.

There are great numbers of young people today who are very sincere and love God. When they feel conviction in a service, they know that it is God drawing them to Himself. And it is nothing less than the person of Jesus Christ calling them to repentance. I thank God that we can still feel the conviction of God. Millions today in the world don't feel it at all. You should thank God every day that you do. Many times God draws us so strong, we find our-selves at the alter pouring our hearts out to Him once again. Repentance comes every so often in a believers life, no matter how long you've been walking with God.

Those experiences are certainly precious to every young believer. But let me surprise you by saying that if that is all you depend on in your spiritual walk, that is not enough.

These young people that I'm speaking of as I said are very sincere, but all to often these are the same youth that can't seem to grasp a consistency in their walk with God. They do fine as long as they're under the annointing of a church service or at least with the saints. But when they're on their own, the pull of the world pulls them down. Thus Satan steals all the joy they just had a few days before. This is strange. What's going on? Their christian walk has a striking resemblance to that of a yo-yo or a roller coaster. The up and down effect. No consistency. Up one week and then down the next. Why is this? By God's grace I'm going to tell you. Nine times out of ten they are young people who have no prayer life, and never fortify themselves by feeding on the word of God.

Let me ask a few questions. What gives you faith? The Bible says "Faith cometh by hearing

and hearing by the Word of God. What brings spiritual growth? The word of God. What brings strength to our spiritual bones. The word of God. What has spiritual food to sustain us? The Word of God. Thus what brings a consistency in our Christian walk? You guessed it. The word of God. If a person continues to have precious experiences and neglects feeding the experience with the Word of God you cannot expect a consistent life. If a young person is having highs and lows in his walk with the Lord, it is evident that he or she does not see the importance of getting into God's word.

Our spiritual strength lies in God's Word of life. Acts 20:32 says "And now brethren; I commend you to God and to the word of His grace, which is able to build you up..."

Do you see what gives strength and builds us up? The word of his grace. Have you ever seen a day like today when there is so much emphasis on building. body Everywhere you go, men and now even women are building up their muscles. Its a popular thing in the world. But I believe its only a type of what's going on spiritually with the Bride of Christ. She's feeding on the "spiritual food in due season", and becoming stronger and stronger, built up by the strength of God's Word. Paul told young Timothy in II Timothy 2:1 "Thou therefore my son be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus." If you need strength to live the life you'll find it in communing with God through His Word.

They tell me that a seed has to have water and sunshine to grow. I know that sounds simple, but why shouldn't we apply it spiritually as well? In the waters of His Word there is strength to grow. What about growing spiritually just like you are physically? That is just as important or even more so. Growing up stronger spiritually only comes from a life that is daily communing with God. Not weekly at church. Not monthly. Not yearly. But daily. I can always tell a person who isn't into Gods Word very much. They're shallow They're inconsistant. They're always carnal. If they would root themselves in the Word, the consistancy would come. The purpose of God sending the revelation of His Word is to make us stable, Founded on a rock, Not sand. The message of the hour is to make us founded on the rock. No more Roller Coaster Christian

walk. Stability in Christ.

These scriptures show
us the importance of

staying in the Word. James 1:22-25.

James 1:22-25. 22 - Be ye doers of the

Word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves.

23 - For if any be a

hearer of the Word, and not a doer, he is like unto a man beholding his natural face in a glass.

24 - For he beholdeth himself, and goeth his way, and straightway forgetteth what manner of man he was.

25 - But whoso looketh into the perfect law of liberty, and continueth therein, he being not a foregetful hearer, but a doer of the work, this man shall be blessed in his deed.

Verses 23 and 24 speak of a person that looks in a glass or mirror but doesn't stay there, He walks away. So he forgets what he looks like. The example here is amazing. When you awake in the morning and look in the mirror, do you look and then just head off to school or work? I doubt it. You stay in the mirror for a while. And the longer you look in it, the more things you see, the more things you notice that have to be changed. Your hair combed, teeth brushed, etc.... What is God's Word typed as? A mirror. As long as you're looking in the mirror of God's Word, you

can see the things in your life that are not right. And then God can drive them out. But you have to stay in the Word.

This brings us back to abiding, continually, daily to receive strength from the Word. John 15:7 says "If ye abide in me and my Words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will and it shall be done unto you." But only if you abide in Him. You have to be connected always with the vine. Daily spending time with God and His Word will bring that satisfying stability you're looking for. A sister once asked Brother Branham, "How can I get closer to God?" His answer may be surprising to you. He simply said, "Read your Bible and pray." You say "There must something greater to it than that!" NO! It's God in simplicity. Read your Bible and Pray. If you only live spiritually on the food you get at a church, I can almost guarantee you'll die.

But if you'll commune with Him daily, you will live. He's given us spiritual food to feed on. Stop waiting for the movie to come out. Read the book

Questions And Answers

* Answers are taken from Bro. William Branham's messages.

Q. How do you feel is the best way to find the Lord's will in some important matters?

A. I tell you, dear friend, the best way to find the will of God in some important matters is prayer. See? Course now, in my case most of the time, if it's very important, I wait on a vision. But many people, God doesn't deal with in visions, I wouldn't advise you to do that. See? Because it's just some people that has visions and some does something else. Where you do something else that I couldn't do maybe - in your way of serving the Lord - I do something that you couldn't do see? God deals with us different.

And so I would if I was in your place and didn't have visions from before the Lord, I would just wait upon the Lord and say, "Lord, now you show me what's the decision to make." And then, the way you feel led to do it, then wait just a little bit, then wait a little while longer, and see which way, which side you lean towards, which way the spirit... say, "Now Father, in my heart you know it doesn't matter but I want to know what you want to do about

That's the way I do about meeting sometime, I feel kind of led to go this way or that way, then I'll follow that way that's the way: to do it, cause it's in

prayer then: you're doing the best you can.

And I believe this, my friends, as Paul was in the new testament in days gone by, he was between two straits, which way he should go. And he started on the wrong road, and he got a Macedonian call, and I believe if you are making a decision for God and do it the best that you can, I believe God will

correct you and see that you don't go wrong. I believe God will do it.

Q. Brother Branham, is it wrong for a young unmarried - to cut her hair?

A. I imagine it's a woman. Yes it's wrong for any woman to cut her hair.

Q. Is it wrong for a woman to curl her hair?

A. Sure, I don't care, just keep it long. You got confidence in me or you wouldn't be asking me that. Now I got confidence in you, sister, that what I'd tell you, I believe you would do. If you haven't got pretty curly hair and you're a woman, you want to look pretty for your husband, for your boyfriend, or something like that, I can't tell you about curling your hair. That's up to you. You just ask the Lord what to do.

Q. What is the meaning of an annulment? Are people free to marry or is this just another word for divorce?

A. Sure they are married. As long as they take that vow, they're married. Just like a boy, if a boy promises a girl to marry her under good faith, he's obligated to that girl. He's just as good as married her. The only thing the law does, is give you a Bill of Rights to live together to keep from being common-law husband and wife. But when a man tells a woman, "I will marry you, honey: I'll take your for my wife, will you take...?" He's married. Your vow is sacred: that's what marries you anyhow there's not a preacher can marry you, no magistrate, or nothing else: it's your own vow to God and to this man, when you promise, you are married.

Did you want the bible on it? "Joseph her husband, being a just man (her espoused husband already called her husband)... Joseph her husband being a just man, was minded to put her away privately on this wise: but before they came together, she was found with a child of the Holy Ghost. (See)? And the angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream and saying, Joseph thou son of David, fear not to take unto thee Mary, thy wife!" Already married, he'd already promised her. And little lady, if you promised to marry that boy, you're obligated to do it. If you marry another after that obligation, you'll be living in adultry, and notice, the same thing to a boy promising to marry a woman...

Don't you make your vow to anybody less you mean to stick with it. Remember, there's the Bible for it. Joseph promised to marry Mary, read the old testament laws on that... the old testament law, if you promised to marry a woman and you married another one, you were committing adultery: and it throwed you out of the camp. Yes, sir. You have to keep your vows when you promise a woman that. She's a sacred little vessel and that's to bring child life into the world again. So when you promise her, you must marry her.

My memory allows me to start in 1972 when my father was led to move to Missouri to start a non-denominational church. In 1975, my father met a man that was in the Message. He was an evangelist so Dad invited him to preach a week of meetings. I just thought that I was on the top, not only in school but as well as ranking second for two years in a row in State Competition with Future Farmers of America. I received many high school awards and was too involved with school to have time for the Lord. Besides working on the natural side, the devil dealt just as hard on me on the spiritual side. My father would sit and talk to me and say that I had to make some changes or the Lord would not bless me. My answer was always the same. "I can't see any life in the ministry or in the young people, so this can't be the end-time Message. If the Lord is coming soon, then I don't know anybody that will go." My heart grew harder and harder towards the Word.

However, I would still go to camp meetings and during these meetings, the Lord would begin to deal strong with me and time and time again I would say, "Lord, I want to live that life not only during camp meetings and on Sunday, like a hypocrite, but rather every day." But, it seemed that one month after camp, I was out doing the same things as before, all over again. One day, I came home from school and was told that a certain Brother Ed Byskal would be having special meetings over the

weekend.

The Lord showed me in these meetings that this was a preacher who lived what he preached. Not too long after that, Brother Lonnie Jenkins was holding special meetings at another church. My family went and the Lord spoke and said "There's that lived out life again!" Brother Earl Grigory was holding Thanksgiving in Wichita, Kansas, which I attended. His message was on forgiveness.

I found myself in the same position as Job. 


